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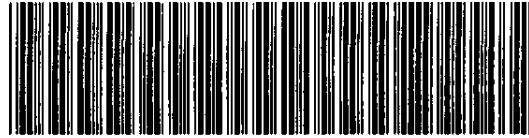

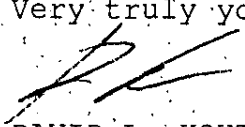

Articles of Incorporation
of
The Metrix Research Group, Inc.

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Not-For-Profit Corporation Act hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

**ARTICLE I
NAME**

The name of the corporation is The Metrix Research Group, Inc.

**ARTICLE II
DURATION**

The term of existence of the corporation is perpetual.

**ARTICLE III
PURPOSE**

The corporation's exclusive purpose is charitable and educational including for such purposes, the making of distributions to community service organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under sections 501.c.3 of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future tax code. Specifically, the corporation's purpose is to provide strategic research and educational evaluation, tracking, trending and reporting of data to continuously improve capacity building and efficacy of community service agencies, community service companies, or specific areas of agencies and companies providing community services, and non-profit organizations.

**ARTICLE IV
MEMBERSHIP**

Membership in the corporation is available by submitting an application of interest subject to approval by the Board of Directors.

**ARTICLE V
REGISTERED OFFICE**

The street address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 2800 North 46th Avenue, Unit 311-A, Hollywood, Florida, 33021 and the name of the initial registered agent at that address is Linda Reesor.

**ARTICLE VI
DIRECTORS**

7.0.1 The initial Board of Directors of the corporation shall consist of three (3) members. Members of the Board of Directors shall be elected by the members of the corporation.

**ARTICLE VIII
DISTRIBUTION OF EARNINGS**

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the

corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on or engage in any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

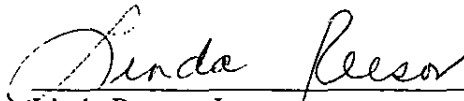
ARTICLE IX DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501.(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of by the court of common pleas of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes. Dissolution shall be in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida and the Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE X COMMENCEMENT OF EXISTENCE

The company shall commence its existence on the date of the filing of these articles.

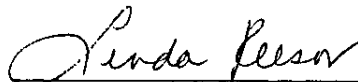
