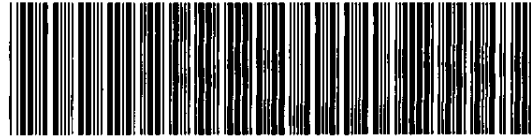

The purpose of this Non Profit Organization is to help improve the literacy rate in Florida's elementary schools. In particular, those schools that have shown a deficiency in the FCAT reading and writing scores in Florida.

This Non Profit Organization will implement board games (i.e. Scrabble©, Upwords©, ect.) at these schools whose FCAT scores can improve by focusing our awareness on literacy, vocabulary and spelling.
