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
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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

FOR

FARMS & FAMILIES ADVOCATING RESPONSIBLE MINING, INC.

The undersigned, desiring to form a not-for-profit corporation pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, certifies and acknowledges:

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of this not-for-profit corporation shall be Farms & Families Advocating Responsible Mining, Inc., hereinafter referred to as the "Corporation."

ARTICLE II

DURATION

The Corporation shall exist perpetually, commencing upon the filing of the Articles of Incorporation with the Florida Department of State, unless dissolved according to law.

ARTICLE III

PURPOSE

The Corporation is organized for the purpose of:

- Representing the collective interest of persons who reside, own property, or have an interest in the protection of the environment and a healthy standard of living within Marion County, Florida (hereinafter referred to as "County");
- 2. Preserving and protecting the County against any proposed and/or existing use of land that fails to meet the stated objectives of protecting existing residential neighborhoods, protecting rural lands and existing farms, protecting the environment, ensuring that any proposed and/or existing use of land, including rock mining operations, is consistent with the surrounding

neighborhood, ensuring compatibility of any proposed and/or existing use of land with adjoining properties, and eliminating uses inconsistent with the community's character or that adversely affect the health, safety, or property values of surrounding property owners;

- Promoting the enhancement of the value of all property within the County and protecting the character and quality of life therein;
- 4. Providing a forum for those who reside, own property, or have an interest in a healthy, clean environment within the County to express their respective ideas and views for the collective benefit of the County; facilitating distribution of accurate and complete information related to areas of concern to the County; expressing to others such collective views concerning matters which affect the County; and taking such action for and on behalf of the Corporation as may from time to time be necessary and appropriate to advance the collective interest concerning matters that affect the County; and
- 5. Engaging in any lawful purpose or purposes not for pecuniary profit.

ARTICLE IV

CAPITAL STOCK

The Corporation will have no stock.

ARTICLE V

PRINCIPAL OFFICE AND MAILING ADDRESS

ARTICLE VI
