

"We Are Still the VMCCA, The Touring Club"

You all know by now that the name change passed with 86% of the vote and we are now the Vintage Motor Car Club of America. Two years ago when Mike Derbidge took office as our new President he and I sat down to discuss what we wanted to accomplish during his term. Mike had just completed a membership survey and the number one thing the membership wanted was to change the name. So we casually said "let's do it" and I volunteered to chair the process. We had no idea what we were getting into. Mike and I started getting calls, emails, and letters from many longtime members that were against the name change. Many of these folks were close friends that I have the utmost respect for and I often sought their advice on issues.

We started soliciting guest editorials from members stating their opinions for or against the change. We tried to be fair in publishing both sides of issues in the Bulb Horn. I was in charge of proofing the editorials and some had to be censored due to strong opinions and wording; some of our members were very passionate about the proposed change.

About a year into the process I sat down with Mike in Florida and told him that I think we should drop it as it was just too divisive and controversial. Mike calmly said, "Everyone who has tried this in the past has said the very same thing, we can do this and I know that this is what the membership wants." Mike never wavered on his belief that this was the best plan for the Club.

Mike passed away just a month after that meeting and I was torn as to what to do. After some solid advice from past presidents I decided that we should try to complete Mike's agenda and go for it. The opinions, emails, and calls continued and due to proper bylaw change procedure we had to make a decision in October at our third quarter BOG meeting whether or not to conduct a membership-wide vote on the name change.

Our meeting was to be a phone conference meeting in the evening and all past presidents, regional directors, and elected officers were to be on the conference call. That was a crazy day - I was on and off the phone all day as I was wavering back and forth whether to keep the issue on the agenda or not. Dennis needed to know quickly, as he was past his deadline for the BH and it was at the printer. Mike Welsh needed to know as he was in charge of the agenda for the meeting. There were issues with the proper wording of the by-law change for a ballot. By midday I decided to postpone the vote for a year so that it would be done right. I will never forget Bill Johnson calling and taking charge of wording the ballot proposal properly so that we could proceed exactly as the by-laws described.

Well, by late afternoon we put the issue back on the agenda and the show began. We had about 25 BOG members on the phone that evening. We got through regular business quickly and the name change issue was next on the

agenda: We quickly got a motion and a second to conduct a vote of the entire membership on the issue. Now we went into discussion. We spent about two hours in discussion. I wanted everyone to be heard. Finally we called a vote and the vast majority voted to conduct the election.

You all received ballots in the mail in late December and about 75% of you mailed the ballots back in. This was a very good response. During the campaign I visited with many of you both for and against the change. I honestly could not get a read on the outcome and I was actually predicting the issue would fail. We brought the unopened ballots to Palm Springs to the site of our membership meeting and appointed a committee of seven members representing our largest regions to open and count the votes. I got a real kick out of the committee as they were so professional and they took their job very seriously.

The committee consisted of: James Woodall from Mid-Atlantic, Judy Wright from Great Lakes, Rich Kelly from Midwest, Liz Lindig from Texoma, Sandi Lappin from Mts. and Plains, Melba Anderson from Southwest Region, and Jo Ann Anderson from Bonneville. The committee took four-and-a-half hours to count the votes and were sworn to secrecy until the Saturday morning meeting.

As the vote results were being read on Saturday morning I already had my sheet of comments ready to read if the issue was defeated. Everyone in the room was stunned when Liz Lindig, committee chairwoman, announced the results that 86% of the membership was in favor of the change. I was shocked and couldn't respond for a minute or so. I even got a bit emotional wishing that Mike Derbidge was there to see it. There was so much excitement in the room and it carried on into the evening at the awards banquet and of-

ficer installation.

As I'm writing this it has been two weeks since the announcement and things are moving fast. Bob Edelman has been busy with legal business pertaining to the change, Mike Welsh is busy with so many clerical issues, and Bill Sullivan has written a beautiful press release and it has been distributed. I have enjoyed many congratulatory calls from other clubs and publications.

All we have done is change one word in our name to stop the confusion of being a military veteran club. We are still the Touring Club and-I want us to continue to promote ourselves as the Touring Club as this is our strength and the backbone of our Club. Touring and-fellowship are what we all-love about this club and that will not change. This issue is behind us so let's go out and get those new members and work equally as hard to keep the wonderful members that we have.
