Veteran Shepherd Inc. (Attachment I)

Article III PURPOSE

- 1.) Veteran Shepherd Inc. (the "corporation") is organized exclusively for charitable, educational and scientific purposes, more specifically to provide Veterans of the United States Armed Forces the opportunities of development through free services including financial planning (education), life skills education, personal finance education, and education of other opportunities that are available to Veterans. The corporation as part of its charitable purposes may also make distributions to other organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- 2.) The assets of the corporation are dedicated to the charitable purpose described in Paragraph 1.) above.
- 3.) Upon termination, dissolution or final liquidation of the Corporation in any manner and for any reason, the Board of Directors shall first pay or provide payment of all liabilities of the Corporation; all remaining assets of the Corporation shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.
- 4.) No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Paragraph 1.) above. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, (except as otherwise provided by Section 501(h) of the Code) and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Furthermore, notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from the federal income tax under Section 501 (c)(3) of the of the Internal Revenue code or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code or by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue code or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
