



ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF Centro Cristiano Luz y Esperanza De Winter Garden

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation is Centro Cristiano Luz y Esperanza de Winter Garden, Inc.

The principal office of the corporation is located at 125 E. Plant St. Winter Garden, Florida 34787

The mailing address of the corporation is P.O.Box 11 Ocoee, Florida 34761.

ARTICLE II

REGISTERED AGENT: The name of the Registered Agent of the corporation is Aracelia Cruz. The address of this registered agent is 125 E. Plant St. Winter Garden, Florida 34787. The mailing address of the Registered Agent of the corporation is P.O.Box 11 Ocece, Florida 34761.

DURATION/MEMBERSHIP: The qualification for membership and the manner of their admission, transfers, and termination shall be regulated by the bylaws.

CHURCH COUNCIL MEMBERS: Jaun A. Agosto, Victor Ramirez, Carlos Rivera. The method of selection of the Church Council members and number of them shall be stated in the bylaws.

INCORPORATORS: The name and address of the incorporator is: Patricio Bravo, 2737 Blowing Breeze Way Orlando, Florida 32820.

The mailing address of the Incorporators is P.O.Box 11 Ocoee, Florida 34761.

ARTICLE III

This corporation is a religious corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Religious Corporation law exclusively for religious purposes.

ARTICLE IV

This corporation is organized exclusively for religious purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding section of any future United States internal revenue law). Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation, and this corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding section of any future United States internal revenue law), or (b) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding section of any future United States internal revenue law).

ARTICLE V

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to religious purposes, and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer or member of this corporation, or to the benefit of any private individual. Upon the winding up and dissolution of this corporation, and after paying or adequately providing for the debts and obligations of the corporation, the remaining assets shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation or corporation that is organized and operated exclusively for religious purposes or charitable purposes and that has established and maintained its tax exempt status under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding section of any future United States internal revenue law).

ARTICLE VI

No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, except as provided in section 501(h) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding secretary of any future United States internal revenue law), and this corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including publishing or distributing statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE VII

Any person (and the heirs, executors and administrators of such person) made or threatened to be made a party to any action, suit of proceeding by reason of the fact that he is or was a Pastor, Church Council Member, Director or Officer of the Corporation shall be indemnified by the Corporation against any and all liability and the reasonable expenses, including attorney's fees and disbursements, incurred by him (or by his heirs, executors or administrators) in connection with the defense or settlement of such action, suit or proceeding, or in connection with any appearance therein, except in relation to matters as to which it shall be adjudged in such action, suit or proceeding that such Pastor, Church Council Member, Director or Officer is liable for negligence or misconduct in the performance of his duties. Such right of indemnification shall not be deemed exclusive of any other rights to which such Director or Officer (or such heirs, executors of administrators) may be entitled apart from this Article.
