Article 1.

The name of the corporation is Fresh Bread of Faith International Ministries, Inc.

Article 2.

The initial registered office of the Corporation shall be at 730 SW 4th Street #A, Dania, FL 33004. The initial registered agent of the Corporation at such address shall be: Byron K. Middleton.
