ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned incorporators, natural persons over 18 years old and competent to make and enter into contracts, for the purposes of forming a corporation under the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act, Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I – NAME

ARTICLE III – PURPOSE

The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, social, religious, civic, educational, literacy and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, making distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) and other related sections of the Internal Revenue Code. The Corporation's purpose is to promote, strengthen, educate and provide care for developmentally disabled individuals on a daily basis and to advocate for other support services that they may need to maintain a quality lifestyle. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a nonprofit corporation or organization exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding sections of any future tax code, or by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding sections of any future tax code.

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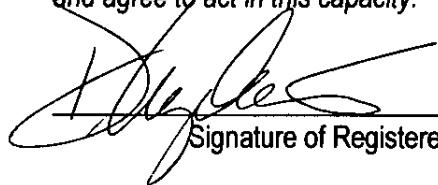
