ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

Selective Prosecution Legal Assistance and Social Help Fund, Inc. A Florida "Not for Profit" Corporation

Article I: The name of the corporation is Selective Prosecution Legal Assistance and Social Help Fund, Inc.

Article II: The principal place of business and mailing address of the Corporation is: 2007 NW 36th Terrace, Gainesville, FL 32605.

Article III: The purposes for which this Corporation is formed are exclusively charitable, educational and scientific and consist of the following:

- 1. The Corporation is formed exclusively for charitable and educational purposes.
- 2. To aid, support, and assist individuals with legal defense costs and perform any legal charitable, educational, or scientific activities.
- 3. To do any and all lawful activities which may be necessary, useful, or desirable for the furtherance, accomplishment, fostering, or attaining of the foregoing purposes, either directly or indirectly, and either alone or in conjunction or cooperation with others, whether such others be persons, organizations of any kind or nature, such as corporations, firms, associations, trusts, institutions, or governmental bureaus, departments or agencies.

Article IV: Limitations:

- 1. The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes.
- 2. The Corporation is not organized nor shall it be operated for the primary purpose of generating pecuniary gain or profit. The Corporation shall not distribute any gains, profits, or dividends to the Directors, Officers, or Members thereof, or to any individual, except as reasonable compensation for services actually performed in carrying out the Corporation's charitable and educational purposes. The property, assets, profits, and net income of the Corporation are irrevocably dedicated to charitable and educational purposes, no part of which shall inure to the benefit of any individual.
- 3. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall consist of the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
- 4. Upon winding up and dissolution of the Corporation, the assets of the Corporation remaining after payment of all debts and liabilities shall be distributed to an organization recognized as exempt under section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to be used exclusively for charitable and educational purposes. If the Corporation holds any assets in trust, such assets shall be disposed of in such a manner as may be directed by decree of the Circuit Court of the district in which the Corporation's principal office is located, upon petition thereof by the Attorney General or by any person concerned in the liquidation.

Article V: Indemnification: Any person (and the heirs, executors and administrators of such person) made or threatened to be made a party to any action, suit or proceeding by the reason of the fact that he is or was a Director or Officer of the Corporation shall be indemnified by the Corporation against any and all liability and the reasonable expenses, including attorney's fees and disbursements, incurred by him (or by his heirs, executors or administrators) in connection with the defense or settlement of such action, suit or proceeding, or in connection with any appearance therein, except in relation to matters as to which it shall be adjudged in such action, suit or proceeding that such Director or Officer is liable for negligence or misconduct in the performance of his duties. Such right of indemnification shall not be deemed exclusive of any other rights to which such Director or Officer (or such heirs, executors or administrators) may be entitled apart from this Article.

Article VI: The method of selection of the Board of Directors and number of directors shall be stated in the bylaws.

Article VII: The Effective Date of the establishment of this Corporation shall be the 18th day of March, 2011.
