ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF STAR OF DAVID HOLINESS CHURCH OF THE LORD JESUS CHRIST, INC.



We, the undersigned, hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of becoming

incorporated under the laws of the State of Florida, applicable to corporations not for profit, under

the following proposed Charter:

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation shall be STAR OF DAVID HOLINESS

CHURCH OF THE LORD JESUS CHRIST, INC., and it is to be located at

9240 N. W. 33RD Place, Sunrise, FL 33351, Broward County, State of

Florida, or outside the State of Florida as may be deemed necessary and proper from time to time.

ARTICLE II - OBJECTIVE

- A. The general nature or the objective of this corporation is to conduct for religious worship and instruct churches, schools, pastoriums, and other institutions connected therewith of a religious, educational, charitable and benevolent character to the end that its own members and others may be generally instructed and guided concerning those articles of faith which are most surely held among STAR OF DAVID HOLINESS CHURCHES OF THE LORD JESUS CHRIST, INC., and to advance spiritual growth and enlightenment, moral and personal purity among its own membership and the people of the community in which it is located; to promote home and foreign missions, and to aid in the spread of the Gospel of Jesus Christ to the end of the earth; also to educate, prepare, and ordain Christian men and women for the ministry of the Gospel of Jesus Christ.
- B. To be governed by the manual of the STAR OF DAVID HOLINESS CHURCH OF THE LORD JESUS CHRIST, INC.. as now being used by the unincorporated membership, and the same may be revised, changed and updated from time to time.

ARTICLE III - MEMBERSHIP

Every person who believes in repentance towards God, and faith in Jesus Christ, as Savior and Lord, and who is willing to confess Him publicly as Lord and King and to observe the ordinances of Christ and to be governed by His Laws, is qualified and eligible for membership in this Corporation.

The manner of admission to membership shall be by letter of dismission from other churches of like faith and order and by satisfactory statement of former membership in a STAR OF DAVID HOLINESS CHURCH OF THE LORD JESUS, INC., and profession of faith upon a favorable majority vote of the membership of the Corporation present at any meeting of the Church.

The present membership of the STAR OF DAVID HOLINESS CHURCH
OF THE LORD JESUS CHRIST, INC., (unincorporated) and those hereafter
admitted to membership shall constitute the membership of this corporation.

ARTICLE IV-TERM

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE VI - OFFICERS

The business and spiritual affairs of this Corporation shall be managed by the following officers:

Constance Riley - President
Lacy Riley - Vice President
Tameko C. Smith - Secretary
Willie Riley, Jr. - Treasurer

and such officers as may be deemed necessary and proper, each of whom shall be elected or appointed at such time and manner as may be prescribed in these Articles of Incorporation or the By-Laws. In matters both spiritual and business, the Bishop-President shall exercise and make the final decision, with the counsel and advice of the officers of the Corporation. The Bishop-President shall be appointed or elected for life subject to removal only for good cause shown. The other officers shall be elected or appointed from the membership to serve for such terms which shall be not less than one (1) year, or as may be provided in the By-Laws. All elections to office shall be by majority vote of the members of the Corporation present at any business meeting of the Corporation. Any two (2) or more offices may be held by the same person, except the offices of Bishop-President and Secretary. The officers of this Corporation may be designated by such additional titles as may be provided in these Articles of Incorporation or the By-Laws.

ARTICLE VII - FIRST OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS

The names of the officers who are to manage all the affairs of the Corporation until the first election or the first appointments under this Charter are as follow:

Bishop - President - Constance Riley
Vice- President - Lacy Riley
Secretary - Tameko C. Smith
Bishop-Treasurer - Willie Riley, Jr.

The Corporation shall have not less than three (3) Directors. The exact number of Directors may be determined by the By-Laws. The first Directors shall be those four (4) persons whose names and addresses are set forth in Article V.

Any officer elected or appointed, if said officer is appointed by the Bishop-President may be removed by the Bishop - President whenever it is the judgment of the Bishop-President that it is in the best interest of the Corporation or if the said officer is elected by the membership, said officer may be removed by the membership whenever it is the judgment of the membership that it is in the best interest of the Corporation.

Any vacancy occurring among the officers shall be filled by a majority vote of the remaining officers, except for the Bishop-President, whose appointment shall require also a majority vote of the membership. An officer elected or appointed to fill a vacancy shall be elected or appointed for the unexpired term of his or her predessor in office.

ARTICLE VIII - RESIDENT AGENT

The initial Resident Agent shall be Bishop-Treasurer, WILLIE RILEY, Jr., and his address is 9240 N. W. 33rd Place, Sunrise, Florida 33351. He is to serve until his successor is named and accepted.

ARTICLE IX - BY-LAWS

The initial by-laws of this Corporation shall be adopted by its officers on a majority vote. The power to alter, amend, or repeal the by-laws or adopt new by-laws shall be vested in the officers of this Corporation, subject to the approval of a majority vote of the members of this Corporation at the annual meeting of the Corporation or any meeting called for said purpose.

ARTICLE X - AMENDMENTS

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended upon a majority vote of the officers of this Corporation and the approval of a majority of the members of the Corporation at its annual meetings or any meeting called for said purpose.

ARTICLE XI - DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS UPON DISSOLUTION

The assets of this Corporation upon dissolution shall be applied and distributed as follows:

- A. All liabilities and obligations of the Corporation shall be paid, satisfied, and discharged, or adequate provision shall be made therefore.
- B. Assets held by the Corporation upon conditions requiring return, transfer or conveyance, which condition occurs by reason of the dissolution, shall be returned, transferred or conveyed in accordance with such requirements.
- C. Assets received and held by the Corporation subject to limitations permitting their use only for charitable, religious, eleemasynary, benevolent, educational or similar purposes, shall be transferred or conveyed to one or more domestic sociaties or organizations engaged in activities substantially similar co to those of the dissolving corporation.
- D. Other assets shall be distributed in carrying out the purpose for which this Corporation was organized.
