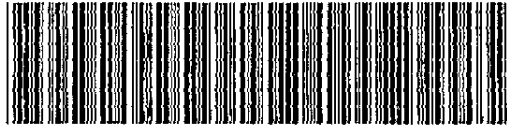

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

THE WARREN LEE FOUNDATION FOR VETERANS, INC

The undersigned foundation for the purpose of becoming a not for profit corporation under Chapter 617, laws of the State of Florida, providing for the formation, liability, rights, privileges and immunities of a non for profit corporation.

Article I

The Warren Lee Foundation for Veterans

Article III

This not for profit is organized exclusively for the services to assist military veterans with housing, educational and scholarship purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1996 or the successor provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law. The purpose of this local organization is focused on assisting veterans with housing and educational, and scholarship needs for those veterans whom have been honorably discharged from the military and are in need of assistance to transition back to the civilian society.

This purpose shall be promoted by, but not limited to , social media communications, meetings, educational workshops, marketing advertisement, community involvement, and public/private partnerships.

To the end that the foregoing objectives and purposes and any related housing and educational charitable purposes may be carried out and or performed and accomplished, this foundation shall have the power to engage only in such activities as shall not constitute business unrelated to its housing and or educational, benevolent, charitable purposes. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by any organization exempt from Federal income tax section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1996 or the successor provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law. Subject to the foregoing limitations , this corporation shall have all of the rights and powers set forth in section 617.0302, Florida Statues.

Article IV

All Directors of the Board shall be elected through the election process by majority vote which is outlined in the bylaws (Article IV, Sec 3)

Article VII

Duration

This foundation shall exist perpetually from this date of April 2, 2011, corporate existence shall commence on the date these Articles are filed.

Article VIII

Distribution

No part of the net earnings of this nonprofit shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the nonprofit shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for the services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause thereof.

No substantial part of the activities of **The Warren Lee Foundation for Veterans** shall be carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the nonprofit shall not participate in, or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, **The Warren Lee Foundation for Veterans** shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a nonprofit organization exempt from federal income taxes under section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by any organization , contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)2 of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Article IX Dissolution

Upon dissolution of **The Warren Lee Foundation for Veterans**, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.
