KINGDOM LIFE TABERNACLE, INC. ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

PREAMBLE

We declare and establish this Constitution to preserve and secure the principles of our faith $\frac{1}{12}$ and to govern the body of the Ministry in an orderly manner which sets the foundation for the anointing, This Constitution will preserve the liberties of each individual member and the $\frac{1}{12}$ freedom of action of the body in its relation to other Churches, and Kingdom advancement.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this Church shall be Kingdom Life Tabernacle which was founded on Sunday April 10, 2011, and Incorporated with the State of Florida on April 19, 2011. The Church is currently located at 1410 E. Indianhead Dr., Suite 1, Tallahassee, Leon County, Florida 32301. The Church is registered as a non-profit corporation with the Florida Department of State, Division of Corporations, as required under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, and is a Section 301(c){3}, non-profit agency under the United States Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE II - CHRISTIAN AFFILIATIONS

Kingdom Life Tabernacle is an Interdenominational Ministry that is currently Independent, but we are accountable to God through the Holy Spirit. Where we believe that the Holy Bible is the unadulterated, unblemished, untainted and divinely inspired Word authorized by God. Kingdom Life Preparatory Academy (KLPA) and KLPA II is an umbrella ministry under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, and is a Section 501(c)(3), non-profit agency under the United States Internal Revenue Code.

ARTECLE III - WHO WE ARE

We are an Interdenominational Ministry with Loving and Compassionate members that embrace those from ALL cultural and socioeconomic backgrounds whose focus is on operating in the Kingdom according to the Word of God.

ARTICLE IV - VISION STATEMENT

To build Kingdom minded individuals who are effective and efficient in the earth realm from a global perspective who Love God and exemplify an unconditional love and acceptance for the people of God.

ARTICLE V - MISSION STATEMENT

To minister to the whole man through "Out of the Box", but in the Book of Kingdom strategies which empower individual to serve God through their Spiritual gifts and talents for the advancement of the Kingdom.

ARTICLE VI – DOCTRINE

Kingdom Life Tabernacle accepts the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments as the inspired record of God's revelatory actions in human history and as the authoritative basis for its doctrine and practice.

ARTICLE VII - CHURCH COVENANT

We believe that the Holy Bible is the unadulterated, unblemished, untainted and divinely inspired Word authorized by God. We believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of the Living God and that He died for our sins, and on the third morning He rose for our justification. We believe in water baptism and observance of the Lord's Supper. We believe in the triune God the Father, God the Son and the Holy Spirit, Jesus Christ is true God and true man. We believe the power, relevancy and the importance in the Name of Jesus Christ.

We believe that there is One Lord, One Faith, One Baptism, and that God is calling for Unity in the Body of Christ based upon this principle.

We believe the Holy Spirit is a divine person. We believe that all scripture is given by the inspiration of God. We believe that "All have sinned and come short of the glory of God" and are in need of salvation which has been provided through Jesus Christ for all men.

We believe it is the will of God that every believer be filled with the Holy Spirit and should walk in that power daily. We believe that healing is provided in the redemptive work of Christ and is available to every Believer. We believe that the Church consists of all who have received Jesus Christ as their personal Savior. We believe there shall be a bodily resurrection of the just and the unjust. We believe in the personal, visible, imminent return of Jesus Christ.

ARTICLE VIII - ARTICLES OF FAITH

The Scriptures: The Holy Bible was written by men divinely inspired and is the record of God's revelation of Himself to man. It is a perfect treasure of divine instruction. It has God for its author, salvation for its end, and truth, without any mixture of error, for its matter. It is inerrant and infallible in its original manuscript which is to be taken as verbally inspired. It reveals the principles by which God judges us; and therefore is and will remain to the end of the world, the true center of Christian union, and the supreme standard by which all human conduct, creeds, and religious opinions should be tried.

God: There is one and only one living and true God. He is an intelligent, spiritual, and personal Being, the Creator, Redeemer, Preserver and Ruler of the universe. God is infinite in holiness and all other perfection. To Him we owe the highest love, respect, reverence, and obedience, The eternal God reveals Himself to us as Father, Son and Holy Spirit, with distinct personal attributes, but without division of nature, essence, or being.

Man: Man was created by the special act of God, in His own image, and is the crowning work of His creation. Ln the beginning man was innocent of sin and was endowed by the Creator with freedom of choice. Through the temptation of Satan, man transgressed the command of

God, and fell from his original innocence; whereby his posterity inherit a nature and an environment inclined toward sin, and soon as they are capable of moral action become transgressors and are under condemnation. Only the grace of God can bring man into His Holy fellowship and enable man to fulfill the creative purpose of God. The sacredness of human personality is evident in that God created man in His own image, and in that Christ died for man; therefore, every man possesses dignity-and is worthy of respect and Christian love.

Salvation: Salvation involves the redemption of the whole man, and is offered freely to all who accept Jesus Christ as Lord and savior who by His own blood obtained eternal redemption for the believer. In its broadest sense salvation includes regeneration, sanctification and glorification.

God's Purpose of Grace: Election is the gracious purpose of God, according to which He regenerates, sanctifies, and glorifies sinners. It is consistent with the free agency of man, and comprehends all the means in connection with the end. It is a glorious display of God's sovereign goodness; and is infinitely wise, holy and unchangeable. It excludes boasting and promotes humility.

The Church: This Church is an autonomous body, operating under the apostolic processes and the Lordship of Jesus Christ. In such a congregation members are equally responsible. Its Scriptural officers are Elders and Deacons.

The Lord's Day: The first day of the week is the Lord's Day. It is a Christian institution for regular observance. It commemorates the resurrection of Christ from the dead and should be employed in exercises of worship and spiritual devotion, both public and private, and by preparation for that rest that remains for the people of God.

Stewardship: God is the source of all blessings, temporal and spiritual; all that we have we owe to Him. Christians have a spiritual debtorship to the whole Word, a holy trusteeship in the gospel, and a binding stewardship in their possessions.

Evangelism and Missions: It is the duty and privilege of every follower of Christ and of every Church of the Lord Jesus Christ to endeavor to make disciples of all nations. The new birth of man's spirit by God's Holy Spirit means the birth of love for others. Missionary efforts on the part of all rest thus upon a spiritual necessity of the regenerate life, and is expressly and repeatedly commanded in the teachings of Christ. It is the duty of every child of God to seek constantly to win the lost by personal effort and by all other methods in harmony with the gospel of Christ.

Education: The need for education in the Kingdom of Christ is to coordinate with the causes of missions and general benevolence, and should receive along with these, liberal support of the Church. An adequate system of Christian schools is necessary to complete a spiritual program for Christ's people. It is the vision of Kingdom Life Tabernacle to have a strong education ministry that reaches and teaches all ages through Walking in the Word (Bible Study), Sunday Afternoon Live (Worship service), Kingdom Institute (Sunday School), King's Kid Church (Children's Church), Real Talk (Teen Church), and even an affiliated Christian School, with a childcare facility.

ARTICLE IX

Board of Directors / Officers

No director shall be personally liable to the Corporation for monetary damages for any breach of fiduciary duty as a Director, except that no Director's liability to the Corporation for monetary damages shall be eliminated or limited on account of any of the following: (a) Any breach of the Director's duty of loyalty to the Corporation; (b) Any acts or . omissions of law; (c) the Director's assent to, or participation in, a loan by the Corporation to any Director or Officer of the Corporation; (d) any transaction in which the Director received improper personal benefit. Nothing herein will be construed to deprive any Director of the right to all defenses ordinarily available to a Director nor will anything herein be construed to deprive any Director of any right for contribution from any other Director or other person. Any repeal or modification of this provision shall be prospective only and shall not adversely affect any right or protection of a Director of the Corporation existing at the time of such repeal or modification.

ARTICLE XI

Purpose and Dissolution:

- (A) Kingdom Life Tabernacle (Said Organization) is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- (B) Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
