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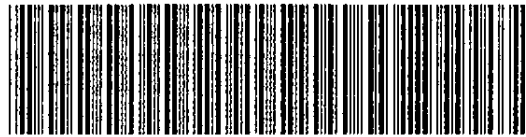

A NON-PROFIT CORPORATION**

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**FIRST:** The name of the Corporation is **Tomorrow's Dreams Today, Inc.**

**SECOND:** The Principal Place of Business is 7577 NW 70<sup>th</sup> Way, Parkland, Florida 33067

**THIRD:** The Mailing Address is same as the Principal Place of Business.

**FOURTH:** The purpose for which this corporation formed is:

- A.) To create innovative programs at affordable costs for special needs children and young adults in the areas of education, athletics, recreation, culture and employment. Also to create a web based hub providing consultation, coordination, networking, referrals, bulletin board and discussion groups for the families of special needs children and young adults. To create volunteer opportunities for typical students and adults to work with special needs children and young adults.
- B.) This Corporation shall be a non-profit corporation. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. 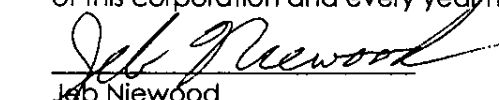

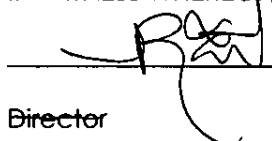

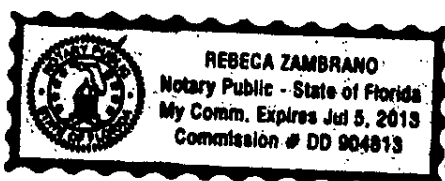
