ARTICLE 1 NAME

TAMPA BAY CLASSIC CHEVY CLUB, INC.

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

The corporation with a special interest in classic Chevy's is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes, and provide a range of socially oriented programs including, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE IV LIMITATIONS

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, exempt that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office, Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or the correspondence section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Neither the members nor the members of the Board of Directors or officers of the Corporation shall be liable for the debts of the Corporation.

This corporation shall have no capital stock and shall be composed of members rather than shareholders.

ARTICLE V MANNER OF ELECTION

The president, vice president, secretary, treasurer, and board of directors of the corporation shall be elected by a majority vote of the members of the corporation annually in April.

ARTICLE VI DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS UPON DISSOLUTION

In the event of the dissolution of the Corporation, no distribution of any of the property or assets of the Corporation shall be made to any member, director, officer or employee of the Corporation, or other private individual, but all of such property and assets shall be applied, in the direction of the directors, to accomplish the charitable purposes for which the Corporation is organized by distributing such property and assets for the furtherance of the work of institutions with similar purposes and objects which are exempt from federal income taxation under Section 501(c))(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, as its successor statute.

ARTICLE VII TERM OF EXISTENCE

The corporation shall have perpetual existence.
