Articles of Incorporation of

Florida Association of Environmental Professionals NW Florida Chapter Inc.

Said organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under the section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. The business activity for said organization is as follows: The Chapter is a unit of FAEP which was formed to promote the goal of enhancing, maintaining and protecting the quality of life in the natural and human environment through the following:

- 1. Encouraging compliance with the NAEP code of ethics and cooperation with the goals of NAEP and FAEP.
- 2. Improving public awareness of the need for environmental involvement.
- 3. Improving communication between the environmental professional and regulated communities and between practitioners within the environmental professional community.
- 4. Improving methods for the collection and utilization of environmental information and providing a forum for dissemination of this information.
- 5. Encouraging the utilization of resources and research for the benefit of the environment.
- 6. Encouraging and providing resources programs which will benefit the environment, for educational programs which will benefit the environment.
- 7. Promoting and enhancing recognition of the environmental professional by seeking State certification.

No substantial part of the activities of this organization shall be the carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and this organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
