#### ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT:

CITRUS YOUTH EDUCATIONAL SYMPHONIC ORCHESTRA, INC. (A Florida Not For Profit Corporation)

#### Document number N11000006228

Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.002 and 617.006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Florida nonprofit corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to its articles of incorporation.

#### MANNER OF ADOPTION:

The amendment was adopted by the members and the number of votes cast for the amendment was sufficient for approval.

These Articles of Amendment were adopted by the board of directors of said organization at a regular meeting with a quorom being present which was held on September 13, 2011. This meeting of the directors met the requirements of both the Articles of Incorporation and the bylaws.

#### THE AMENDEMENTS

The Articles of Incorporation of the Citrus Youth Educational Symphonic Orchestra, Inc. are hereby amended as follows:

The following additional Article is hereby added to the Articles of Incoporation. Article IX reads as folows:

### ARTICLE IX 501(c)(3) Limitations

- Α. Corporate Purposes. Said organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- Dissolution. Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets В. shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
