ARTICLE HI PURPOSE

The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes as described under Section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue code or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, including, but not limited to:

- Providing an organization that will promote better and more effective communication between government officials and lay citizens;
- Providing a basis for the further development of citizens' understanding of our democracy and the political processes, by educating voters and registering qualified persons to vote;
- Providing educational opportunities by way of political workshops, lectures, classes, field trips, luncheons;
- Development of mentoring relationships between elected representatives and young people desiring to study politics;
- Providing a forum for the exploration of community problems relating to quality of life, social welfare, health, aging and other relevant social or political issues;
- Participating in any grant, program, benefits or services available under any federal, state, or local law from any other person or organization or agency which furthers the purpose of the Orange County Voters League;
- The making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3).

ARTICLE IV DIRECTORS AND MANNER OF ELECTION

The management of the association shall be vested in the Board of Directors, as defined in the corporation's bylaws. No Director shall have any right, title, or interest in or to any property of the corporation. Directors will be elected by the membership at the annual meeting.

ARTICLE VI LIMITATIONS

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof.

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE VII DEDICATION OF ASSETS

Upon the dissolution, termination, or winding up of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
