Article 3. Shares. No shares of stock have been issued.

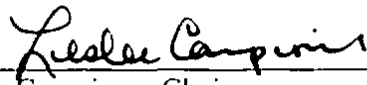
Article 4. Debts. All debts of the Corporation have been paid or adequate provisions have been made to pay and discharge such liabilities and obligations.
