ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF KINGDOM LIFE PREPARATORY ACADEMY, INC.



ARTICLE I

Name of Organization:

The name of the corporation shall be KINGDOM LIFE PREPARATORY ACADEMY, INC. herein referred to as the Corporation.

ARTICLE II

Address:

The initial, principal place of business address of the Corporation is 2532 West Tharpe Street, Tallahassee, Florida 32304; and the mailing address is PO Box 2523 Tallahassee, Florida 32316.

ARTICLE III

Mission Statement:

To prepare and empower students to step into greatness. To fulfill their purpose in life and achieve their destiny by laying a strong foundation through a well balanced quality academic and enrichment program that reaches the whole child.

ARTICLE IV

Vision Statement:

To raise up a generation that will walk in obedience for Kingdom advancement by changing mindsets through the unadulterated word of God, strategies and other divinely inspired creative ideas. To educate students on making good choices so they will become positive leaders of tomorrow.

ARTICLE V

Purpose:

(A) The purpose of this Corporation is to establish, maintain, promote and operate a Christian school with a childcare facility. To effectuate this purpose, the Corporation shall be deemed to be organized exclusively for charitable, religious and educational purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

- (B) Within the scope of the foregoing, the specific purpose of the Corporation is to operate a private, Christian school, and in all things bring glory to God alone. The Corporation will assist Christian families in the education and upbringing of their children by providing a stimulating academic program in a distinctly Christ-centered environment expressly designed to equip students to a life of moral and spiritual integrity, excellence in all endeavors, personal and social responsibility, and zeal to love and serve a Holy God.
- (C) The Corporation shall fulfill these objectives through the presentation of a suitable program and formal instruction, through a regular body of faculty and sound curricula, directed to a regularly enrolled body of students. This shall be at such regular location (s) as shall be designated by the Board of Directors.
- (D) Except as reasonable compensation for services rendered or to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in this Article, no part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to the Corporation's members, directors, officers or other private persons.
- (E) Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (i) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or a corresponding section of any future federal income tax code, or (ii) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal income tax code.

ARTICLE VI

Initial Board of Directors / Officers:

- (A) The initial Board of Directors (School Board) of the corporation shall consist of five members. The number, qualifications, duties and manner of appointment shall be set forth in the Bylaws. The members are as follows:

 - (3) Phillip Bacon P.O. Box 12039 Tallahassee, FL 32317

There are currently two (2) vacant positions.

(B) No director shall be personally liable to the Corporation for monetary damages for any breach of fiduciary duty as a director, except that no director's liability to the Corporation for monetary damages shall be eliminated or limited on account of any of the following: (a) Any breach of the director's duty of loyalty to the Corporation; (b) Any acts or omissions of the director not in good faith or that involve intentional misconduct or a knowing violation of law; (c) the director's assent to, or participation in, a loan by the Corporation to any director or officer of the corporation; (d) any transaction in which the director received improper personal benefit. Nothing herein will be construed to deprive any director of the right to all defenses ordinarily available to a director nor will anything herein be construed to deprive any director of any right for contribution from any other director or other person. Any repeal or modification of this provision shall be prospective only and shall not adversely affect any right or protection of a director of the Corporation existing at the time of such repeal or modification.

ARTICLE VIII

Duration:

The Corporation will exist perpetually, unless dissolved by law.

ARTICLE IX

Statement of Faith:

The following Statement of Faith summarizes the foundational beliefs underlying the purposes of the Corporation. It is mandatory that all directors, officers, and any person (s) seeking employment by the Corporation profess the Statement of Faith as a condition to his or her nomination, election, appointment, engagement and retention.

The Scriptures: The Holy Bible was written by men divinely inspired and is the record of God's revelation of Himself to man. It is a perfect treasure of divine instruction. It has God for its author, salvation for its end, and truth, without any mixture of error, for its matter. It is inerrant and infallible in its original manuscript which is to be taken as verbally inspired. It reveals the principles by which God judges us; and therefore is , and will remain to the end of the world, the true center of Christian union, and the supreme standard by which all human conduct, creeds, and religious opinions should be tried.

God: There is one and only one living and true God. He is an intelligent, spiritual, and personal Being, the Creator, Redeemer, Preserver and Ruler of the universe. God is infinite in holiness and all other perfection. To Him we owe the highest love, respect, reverence, and obedience. The eternal God reveals Himself to us as Father, Son and Holy Spirit, with distinct personal attributes, but without division of nature, essence, or being.

Man: Man was created by the special act of God, in His own image, and is the crowning work of His creation. In the beginning man was innocent of sin and was endowed by the Creator with freedom of choice. Through the temptation of Satan, man transgressed the command of God, and fell from his original innocence; whereby his posterity inherit a nature and an environment inclined toward sin, and soon as they are capable of moral action become transgressors and are under condemnation. Only the grace of God can bring man into His Holy fellowship and enable man to fulfill the creative purpose of God. The sacredness of human personality is evident in that God created man in His own image, and in that Christ died for man; therefore, every man possesses dignity and is worthy of respect and Christian love.

Salvation: Salvation involves the redemption of the whole man, and is offered freely to all who accept Jesus Christ as Lord and savior who by His own blood obtained eternal redemption for the believer. In its broadest sense salvation includes regeneration, sanctification and glorification.

God's Purpose of Grace: Election is the gracious purpose of God, according to which He regenerates, sanctifies, and glorifies sinners. It is consistent with the free agency of man, and comprehends all the means in connection with the end. It is a glorious display of God's sovereign goodness; and is infinitely wise, holy and unchangeable. It excludes boasting and promotes humility.

The Church: This Church is an autonomous body, operating under the apostolic processes and the Lordship of Jesus Christ. In such a congregation members are equally responsible. Its Scriptural officers are Elders and Deacons.

The Lord's Day: The first day of the week is the Lord's Day. It is a Christian institution for regular observance. It commemorates the resurrection of Christ from the dead and should be employed in exercises of worship and spiritual devotion, both public and private, and by preparation for that rest that remains for the people of God.

Stewardship: God is the source of all blessings, temporal and spiritual; all that we have we owe to Him. Christians have a spiritual debtorship to the whole Word, a holy trusteeship in the gospel, and a binding stewardship in their possessions.

Evangelism and Missions: It is the duty and privilege of every follower of Christ and of every Church of the Lord Jesus Christ to endeavor to make disciples of all nations. The new birth of man's spirit by God's Holy Spirit means the birth of love for others. Missionary efforts on the part of all rest thus upon a spiritual necessity of the regenerate life, and is expressly and repeatedly commanded in the teachings of Christ. It is the duty of every child of God to seek constantly to win the lost by personal effort and by all other methods in harmony with the gospel of Christ.

Education: The need for education in the Kingdom of Christ is to coordinate with the causes of missions and general benevolence, and should receive along with these, liberal support of the Church. An adequate system of Christian schools is necessary to complete a spiritual program for Christ's people. It is the vision of Kingdom Life Tabernacle (KLT) through the birthing of Kingdom Life Preparatory Academy (KLPA). The education ministry of KLT also includes Walking in the Word (Bible Study), Sunday Afternoon Live (Worship service), Kingdom Institute (Sunday School), King's Kid Church (Children's Church), Real Talk (Teen Church), with a development of a Christian seminary in the North Florida area.

ARTICLE X

Property:

No member shall have any right, title or interest in the assets of the Corporation. The ownership of all property (real, personal or mixed) acquired by this school shall be vested exclusively in this Corporation, and title the same shall be taken in its name alone. The school Board, subject to approval of the members, shall have the power and authority to accurate, bargain, sell, convey, mortgage, lease, sub-lease, assign, or release any real estate, and to erect schoolhouses and other buildings for the direct and legitimate use of said school, and to alter and repair the same.

ARTICLE XI

Amendments:

The Corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any provision in these Articles of Incorporation in the manner prescribed by law and in this Article IX. Any amendment or repeal of these Articles require the approval of a majority of the directors, pursuant to a vote at a meeting of the members duly called to consider the amendment or repeal.
