### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

## NEGRESS MO. S.S. A. K. S.S. KIWANIS CLUB OF BRADFORDVILLE, TALLAHASSEE, INC. In compliance with Charter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit)

Article I Name The name of the corporation shall be: Kiwanis Club of Bradfordville, Tallahassee, Inc.

Principle Office The principle street address and mailing address shall be: 497 Stone House Road, Tallahassee, Florida 32301

#### Article III Purposes for which corporation is organized

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is:

- (1) The corporation is a public benefit corporation formed to promote and uphold the objects of Kiwanis International through club projects and activities which serve and support the needs of the community
- (2) The purposes for which said corporation is formed are to assist needy persons, particularly young people; to assist worthy youth in attaining vocational excellence, and to aid handicapped persons in regaining happy, useful lives through the expenditure of funds directly for such purposes or by the furnishing of funds to other organizations that are organized for charitable, scientific research, or educational purposes, or the prevention of cruelty to children, all within the purview of Section 501 (c) (4) of the Internal Revenue Code and the Regulations thereunder.
- (3) The specific purposes for which said corporation is formed are to raise funds and provide financial support for the benefit of the youth of Leon and other counties, to support programs, as approved by the Board of Directors, for scholarships, safety, education, athletics, good citizenship and health that benefit the children of Leon and other counties, and to support programs adopted by Kiwanis International for the benefit of youth in the United States and other countries.

Other purposes are:

- (4) To give primacy to the human and spiritual rather than to the material values of life.
- (5) To encourage the daily living of the Golden Rule in all human relationships.
- (6) To promote the adoption and the application of higher social, business, and professional standards.

- (7) To develop, by precept and example, a more intelligent, aggressive, and serviceable citizenship.
- (8) To provide through this club, a practical means to form enduring friendships, to render altruistic service, and to build better communities.
- (9) To cooperate in creating and maintaining sound public opinion and high idealism which make possible the increase of righteousness, justice, patriotism, and good will.
- (10) For the purpose aforesaid, to take over the assets, rights and franchises of the unincorporated club, known as the Kiwanis Club of Bradfordville, Tallahassee.
- (11) To do all such things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects.

<u>Article IV</u> <u>Manner of Election of Board of Directors</u> The authorized number and qualifications of members of the corporation, the different classes of membership, if any, the property, voting, and other rights and privileges of members, and their liability or assessments and the method of collection thereof, shall be stated in the bylaws.



#### **Article IX Miscellaneous**

- (1) Whenever requested by the Board of Trustees of Kiwanis International the proposed corporation will dissolve or change its form of organization, and that no change in the corporate structure, or in the purposes and powers of the proposed corporation should be made without the consent of Kiwanis International.
- (2) Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the governing board shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation, in such manner to such organization or organizations organized or operated exclusively for charitable, education, religious, or scientific purposes, as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law), as the governing board shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the District Court in the country in which the principal office of the corporation is located, exclusively for such purposes.
