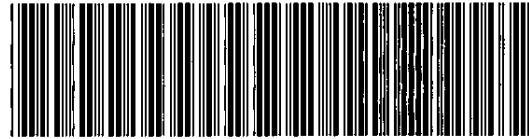

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as the incorporators for not-for-profit Corporation pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE I NAME OF CORPORATION

The name of the corporation shall be **FIRE FIGHTER'S FIGHTING CANCER, CORP.**
The principal place of business of the corporation shall be **2719 SW 8th Place, Cape Coral, Florida 33914.**

ARTICLE II NATURE OF BUSINESS

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation is to raise money and support cancer patients, cancer research or any other related activities.

In addition the corporation shall have power:

(1) to conduct business in, have one or more offices in, and buy, hold, mortgage, sell, convey, lease or otherwise dispose of real and personal property, including franchises, patents, copyrights, trademarks and licenses, in the State of Florida and in all other states and countries;

(2) to contract debts and borrow money, issue and sell or pledge bonds, debentures, notes and other evidences of indebtedness, and execute such mortgages, transfers of corporate property, or other instruments to secure the payment of corporate indebtedness as required;

(3) to purchase the corporate assets of any other corporation and engage in the same or other character of business;

(4) to guarantee, endorse, purchase, hold, sell, transfer, mortgage, pledge or otherwise acquire or dispose of the shares of the capital stock of, or any bonds, securities, or other evidences of

indebtedness created by any other corporation of the State of Florida or any other state or government, and while owner of such stock to exercise all the rights, powers and privileges of ownership, including the right to vote such stock; and

(5) to engage in any and all other activity or business whatever permitted under the laws of the United States and of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE III

The purposes for which this corporation is organized is exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, literary and educational within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Revenue law. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law. The corporation will carry out this purpose by providing financial support for cancer patients, cancer research, management programs through gifts, donations, bequests and grants; promoting public awareness of cancer, and; any other programs or activities that encourage Floridians to support the programs of the Fire Fighter's Fighting Cancer, Corporation. The period of the duration of this corporation is perpetual unless dissolved according to law. Subject to the limitations applicable to Section 501(c)(3) organizations, the corporation shall have the general powers set forth in Section 617.0302, Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE IV

The method of election of the board of directors is as stated in the bylaws. This corporation is a nonmembership organization.

ARTICLE V

The number constituting the initial Board of Directors of the corporation is three (3), and the names and addresses of the persons who are to serve initially are:

ARTICLE VI

In the event of dissolution, the residual assets of the organization will be turned over to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in Sections 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or corresponding sections of any prior or future law, or to the Federal, State, Local Government for exclusive public purpose.

ARTICLE X
INDEMNIFICATION

The corporation shall indemnify any officer or director or any former officer or director, to the full extent permitted by law.

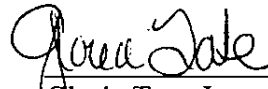
ARTICLE XI

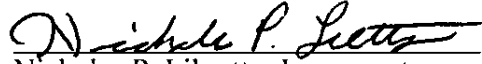
ARTICLE XII

In the event of a dispute between the two initial incorporators which can not be resolved between the parties, the parties agree to submit the dispute to binding arbitration. The parties agree

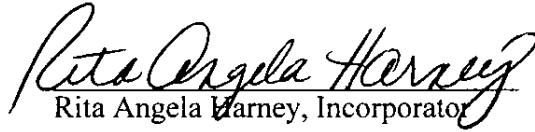
to use the mediation department utilized by the Circuit Court of the 20th Judicial Circuit.
