(6) To carry on any of the aforesaid activities or purposes either directly, or as an agent for or with other persons, associations or corporations;

(7) To carry on any activity and to deal with and expand any such property or income there from for any of the aforesaid purposes without limitation, except such limitations, if any, as many be contained in the instrument under which such property is received, the Certificate of Incorporation, the By-Laws of the Corporation, or any other limitations as are prescribed by law, provided that no such activity shall be such as is not permitted by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or any corresponding future provision of said Code, and that the
