



ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF TWO RIVERS HISTORICAL ASSOCIATION, INC. (A non-profit corporation)

The undersigned subscriber(s) to these Articles of Incorporation, each being a natural person and competent to contract, hereby associate themselves to form a CORPORATION NOT FOR PROFIT under the Laws of the State of Florida:

ARTICLE I.

THE NAME of the corporation is:

TWO RIVERS HISTORICAL ASSOCIATION, INC.

ARTICLE II.

THE PURPOSES for which the corporation is formed, and the objects to be carried on and promoted by it are:

- a. To preserve the historical integrity of Crestview and North Okaloosa County, Florida to promote, enhance and support historical restorations and other lawful purposes, including the making of distributions to organizations that quality as exempt organizations.
- To have all the powers granted corporations NOT FOR PROFIT under the laws of the
 State of Florida.

ARTICLE IX.


THE BY-LAWS of this corporation shall be made, altered or amended by the Board of Directors, or by two-thirds vote of the active members.
