ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit)

ARTICLE I NAME OF THE CORPORATION

The name of this corporation shall be Palm Beach Community Church Foundation, Inc.

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE

ARTICLE III EXISTENCE

This corporation shall exist perpetually unless dissolved according to law.

ARTICLE IV PURPOSE

The purposes for which Palm Beach Community Church Foundation, Inc is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, literary and educational including, but not limited to, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as tax-exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

The powers of Palm Beach Community Church Foundation, Inc. are limited to those within the scope of section 501(c)(3) of the internal revenue code of 1986 of the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

Notwithstanding any other provision of the Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code.


