# Articles of Incorporation

In compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit)

### ARTICLE I: NAME

The name of this corporation shall be FOR CHILD ADVOCACY, INC.

### ARTICLE II: PRINCIPAL OFFICE:

Principal address is located at 4885 Monroe Forest Dr Jacksonville, FL 32257. The mailing address is the same, as the principal address.

### ARTICLE III : PURPOSE

For Child Advocacy, Inc., is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, scientific, and educational purposes, more specifically to help ensure every child's physical, mental, emotional, spiritual, and education well-being by promoting and delivering excellence through advocacy, service, education, research, and leadership.
