## Articles of Incorporation of 30-20-10 LEAP, Incorporated

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The undersigned, a majority of whom are citizens of the United States, desiring to form a Non-Profit Corporation under the Non-Profit Corporation Law of Florida do hereby certify the following.

First: The name of the Corporation shall be 30-20-10 LEAP, Incorporated.

**Second:** The principal office of this Corporation is located in Lake County, Florida. Its physical address is 21644 County Road 44A East, Eustis, Florida 32736.

Third: Said Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future Federal tax code. 30-20-10 LEAP, Inc. is a liberal education arts program. It provides a daily class for children attending public school, beginning in Grade 1 and eventually progressing through Grade 12. This program consists of instruction in music, ancient Greek, and visual arts. The goal of 30-20-10 LEAP, Inc. is to demonstrate that students who receive intense education in the rudiments of music, ancient Greek and art score significantly higher in math, science, and language arts than those students who do not enjoy the same opportunity.

**Fourth:** The Directors of this Corporation will be elected by a majority vote of the Officers of the Corporation. Such vote shall be taken at each annual meeting of the Officers of the Corporation.

**Fifth:** No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be in the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation

shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a Corporation exempt from Federal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or (b) by a Corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future Federal tax code.

Sixth: Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed to one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal government, or to a state or local government for public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
