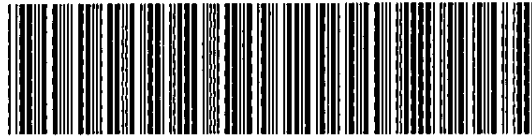

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Articles of Incorporation of the undersigned, a majority of whom are citizens of the United States, desiring to form a Non-Profit Corporation Law of Florida, do hereby certify:

First: The Name of the Corporation shall be **Kingdom Life International Ministries, Inc.**

Second: The place in this State where the principle office of the Corporation is to be located is the City of Tallahassee, Leon County.

Third: The said Corporation, **Kingdom Life International Ministries Inc.**, is organized and formed exclusively for charitable, religious and educational purposes, within the meaning of 501(c)(3). Including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt under section 501(c)(3) And exempt from taxation under 501(a) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Fourth: The manner in which the directors are elected and appointed are as follows: Passing an application process, which includes a criminal background check. A satisfactory interview, level of experience in field and a 2/3 vote.

Initial Trustees of the Corporation are as follows:

Fifth: No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall enure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons except the Corporation, shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any politic campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any

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future federal tax code. Or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. "Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation."

Sixth: The assets of this organization are permanently dedicated to exempt purposes. Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes, In witness whereof, we have hereunto subscribed our names this 28th day of October 2011.

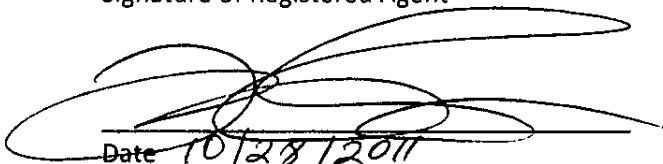
