ARTICLE OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
NORTHWEST FALCONS PARENTS BOOSTER CLUB INC.  
A FLORIDA NOT-FOR PROFIT CORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as the incorporator of a not for profit corporation under the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, as set forth in Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, as amended, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such Corporation:

ARTICLE I: NAME

The name of the Corporation shall be: Northwest Falcons Parents Booster Club Inc. hereinafter referred to as the "Corporation".

ARTICLE II: PRINCIPAL OFFICE AND MAILING ADDRESS

ARTICLE III: PURPOSES

The Corporation is organized and operated exclusively for religious, charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. 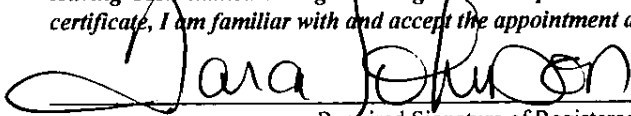
#### ARTICLE IX: AMENDMENTS

#### ARTICLE X: DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS UPON DISSOLUTION

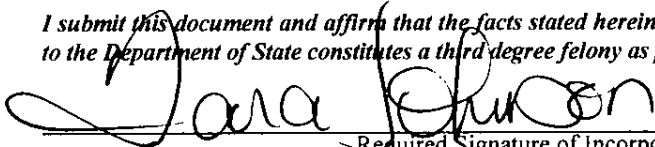
