ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
CAMBODIAN MOTHERS' LEGACY FOUNDATION, INC.
(A Corporation Not for Profit)

ARTICLE I
CORPORATE NAME

The name of the corporation shall be: Cambodian Mothers' Legacy Foundation, Inc.

ARTICLE II
PURPOSE

2.a). General Purpose. The general purpose of the Foundation is to receive and administer funds for charitable and other tax exempt purposes within the meaning of 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (as amended) including, for such purposes:

- i) The administration of funds donated for charitable purposes.
- ii) The making of distributions for such purposes in accordance with the terms of donations, bequests or devises to the Foundation not inconsistent with the purposes of the Foundation.
- iii) The making of distributions to qualified charitable organizations.
- iv) Providing for distributions from time to time of property held by the Foundation in such manner that charitable purposes will be effectively served notwithstanding changed conditions that may have arisen or will arise in the charitable needs of the area served by the Foundation from the time of original receipt from a donor.
- v) Engage in any and all charitable activities as the Board of Directors may determine to undertake.

2.b). Specific Purposes. The specific purposes of the Foundation include, without limitation, the following:

- i) Unite first and subsequent generations of Cambodian-American women, friends and advocates of women's rights and women empowerment, for the purpose of sharing thoughts and ideas on how to bring positive change to the lives of Cambodian impoverished women.
- ii) Organize periodic social gathering among the Cambodian-American community in the U.S. to promote awareness, education, and action to help advance Cambodian women's leadership through social, economic, and political means.
- iii) Organize fund raising and solicit grants to support the work of Cambodia's civil society and activists who are dedicated to protect and defend the rights of Cambodia's impoverished women and children.

2.c). No part of the earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of any Member, Director or Officer of the Corporation, or any other person (except that the Corporation may pay reasonable compensation for services rendered to or on behalf of the Corporation and may make other payments and distributions in furtherance of one or more of its purposes), and no Member, Director or Officer of the Corporation, or any other person shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the Corporate assets on dissolution of the Corporation.

2.d). No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation. The Corporation shall not have the objectives nor engage in activities which would characterize it as an "action organization" as define in section 1.501(c)(3) – 1(c)(3) of the Treasury Regulations, as it now exist or may hereafter be amended.

2.e). Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, the Corporation shall not conduct or carry on any activities not permitted to be conducted or carried on by an organization exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or by any organization, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2).

ARTICLE III MEMBERSHIP AND DIRECTORS

The qualification of Members and Directors and the manner of their admission shall be determined under and pursuant to the By-Laws of this Corporation.

ARTICLE IV INITIAL REGISTERED AGENT PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The Corporation's initial Registered Agent and Registered Office and the Corporation's Principal Office in the State of Florida shall be: BORASMY N. UNG, 2480 E. Commercial Blvd., PH, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33308.

ARTICLE V BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The number of Directors may be altered from time as determined under and pursuant to the By-Laws of this Corporation. However, the Corporation shall have no less than three (3) Directors at any time.

ARTICLE VI INITIAL DIRECTORS
