ARTICLE III- PURPOSE

- 1) The organizational purpose of Fundacion Humanitaria "Frank Pais", Inc. is to provide support to individuals and families of political prisoners in Cuba. This support will be in the form of both in-kind support as well as financial support. Any such asset not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purpose or to such organization or organizations as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
