ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

MEN OF DESTINY COMMUNITY OUTREACH, INC.

WE, the undersigned, hereby certify that we have associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a non-profit, charitable, Florida Corporation under a Charter as follows:

ARTICLE I

The name of the Corporation is MEN OF DESTINY COMMUNITY OUTREACH, INC. and is shall conduct its operations and its place of business principally within the United States, and incidentally outside the territory of the United States as may be determined by the By-laws except as restricted herein. The corporation shall be located 3650 NW $44^{\rm th}$ Avenue, Lauderdale Lakes, Broward County, State of Florida.

ARTICLE II

The name of the registered agent of this corporation shall be ELDER DOUGLAS RUSSELL, JR.

ARTICLE III

This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE IV

The purposes for which the corporation is formed are:

- a. To provide men of the community who are unprivileged and unserved, unemployed, with the social, economical, political, environmental and educational needs, to empower them to become more productive citizens in the community.
- b. To buy, own, hold, contract, impose, mortgage, rent, lease, sell, convey and otherwise acquire and dispose of real, personal or mixed property, or any right, interest or estate therein as owner or otherwise.
- c. To buy, own, hold, contract, impose, mortgage, rent, lease, sell convey, and otherwise acquire and dispose of real,

personal or mixed property, or any right, interest or estate therein as owners of otherwise.

- d. To contract, build, repair, maintain, operate, and lease houses, buildings, or other improvements on property owned or controlled by the corporation.
- e. To borrow money, and contract debts when necessary for the exercise of its corporate rights, privileges, or franchises, or for any other lawful purposes of its incorporation; to issue bonds, promissory notes, bills of exchange, debentures, and other obligations and evidence of indebtedness payable at specific event or events, whether secured by mortgage, pledge, or otherwise, or unsecured for money borrowed or in payment for property purchased or acquired or any other lawful object of objects.
- f. To organize a non-profit corporation and to associate together persons, associations and corporations in order to operate exclusively for all objections and described, permitted and limited in Section 501(e)(4) and (d) and 401(e) of the 1954 Internal Revenue Code. for purposes and powers as set forth herein these Articles of Incorporation, references as the provisions and all appropriate regulations and rulings of the Internal Revenue Service pursuant thereto.
- g. To engage in any and all lawful activities which are incidental to the foregoing purposes except as restricted herein.
- h. To do any and all lawful things for all objectives which are religious, charitable, scientific, literary or educational, and to do any and all lawful things pursuant to all objectives and programs of the Economic Opportunity Act of 1964, as amended, or any similar Act which is passed by Florida or American Legislature, and pursuant to the purposes of community development, as described, permitted, and limited as tax exempt purposes pursuant to Section 501(e)(4) of the above described Code.
- i. To make contributions to any organization described in Section 501(e) and (d) of the above described Code with the exception of organization testing for public safety.
- j. To do all lawful things in promotion of social welfare of the people in the community and to bring about civil betterment and social improvement with all methods allowed an organization tax exempt as a social welfare organization, as described, permitted and limited pursuant to Section 501(c)(4) of the above described Code, including, as set forth therein, the advocacy of rejection of legislation.

ARTICLE V

In the event of dissolution, the residual assets of the organization will be turned over to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in Section 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(c) of the Internal Revenue Code, or to the Federal, State or Local government for exclusive public purpose.

ARTICLE VI

This corporation not for profit shall be perpetual existence.

ARTICLE VII

Membership of this corporation shall be attained by recruiting members from local churches, organizations, parks and recreational centers, and schools through radio and newspaper advertisements, and word of mouth.

ARTICLE VIII


