ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a not for profit corporation pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I CORPORATE NAME, PRINCIPAL OFFICE AND MAILING ADDRESS

The name of this Corporation shall be: CALISTA K. FARMER CANCER FOUNDATION, INC., with its principal office located at 3319 Silver Palm Drive, Edgewater, Florida 32141 and its corporate mailing address being the same.

- (c) <u>Excess Business Holdings</u>. The corporation shall not retain any excess business holdings as defined in Section 4943(c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws.
- (d) <u>Investments Jeopardizing Charitable Purpose</u>. The corporation shall not make any investments in such manner as to subject it to tax under Section 4944 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws.
- (e) <u>Taxable Expenditures</u>. The corporation shall not make any taxable expenditures as defined in Section 4945(d) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax law.


