

The Central Florida Scorpions, Inc.

Said organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under the section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. The business activity for said organization is as follows: The Central Florida Scorpions was established as an organization to promote and help develop the playing skills of young adult men in the sport of football. Not only for the possibilities of playing at a higher level, but also for the simple love of the game. The Central Florida Scorpions looks to be an active and positive force in the local community, providing our time and energy in such places as hospitals, churches, schools, nursing homes, and other community related organizations where positive attitudes, moral judgments, and healthy lifestyles are a way of living. Building good leadership roles, strong character, sportsmanship, and discipline will be the corner stone of our success.
