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ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDED AND RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF ST. MARY'S CARE SERVICES, INC.

Pursuant to the provisions of 617.1001, 617.1002, and 617.1006 of the Florida Statutes, St. Mary's Care Services, Inc., a Florida not for profit corporation, adopts the following Articles of Amendment (this "Amendment") to its Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation:

1. <u>Name of Corporation</u>. The name of the Corporation is St. Mary's Care Services, Inc. (the "Corporation").

2. <u>Text of Amendment</u>. Article XIV is deleted in its entirety and the following is substituted in its stead:

ARTICLE XIV DISSOLUTION AND DISTRIBUTION

Upon the dissolution or liquidation of the Corporation, whether <u>de jure</u> or <u>de facto</u>, in whole or in part, the Corporation's Board of Trustees shall adopt a resolution recommending a plan of distribution and directing its submission to a vote by the Members of the Corporation. The Members shall determine the distribution of all assets of the Corporation not disposed of in discharging the Corporation's liabilities or otherwise distributed in accordance with applicable legal requirements. Such assets of the Corporation shall be distributed only to such not for profit corporations as are then exempt from taxation under Section 501(a) of the Code as an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) thereof. In the event the distributee designated by the Members is not an exempt organization that is then exempt from taxation under Section 501(a) of the Corporation will be distributed to another organization that is then exempt from taxation under Section 501(a)of the Code as an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) thereof.

3. <u>Date and Manner of Adoption</u>. This Amendment was adopted by the Limited Member on June 28, 2001. The numbers of votes cast in favor of the Amendment was sufficient for adoption.
