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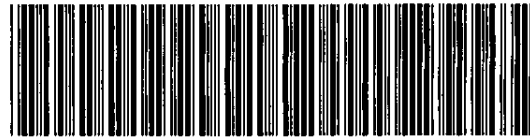

Section 1.01 - Unity in the Community of Pompano Beach, Inc..
