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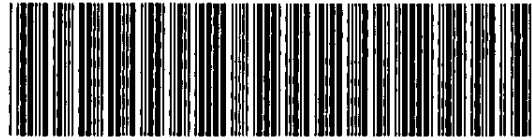

ARTICALS OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a non-profit corporation, pursuant to chapter 617 Florida Statutes, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be:

Bay County Local Post 1606, The Society Of Forty Men And Eight Horses, Incorporated

ARTICLE III

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is:

For God and country we associate ourselves together for the following purposes; To create a fraternal, charitable and non-profit organization; to uphold and defend the Constitution of the United States of America; to assist and promote the welfare and well-being of those who served in the Armed Forces of the United States of America during World War I, World War II, the Korean and Vietnam Conflicts, as well as conflicts/campaigns recognized by congress of the United States of America, and widows and orphans of veterans; to participate in all memorial services for and to be present at the funerals of departed comrades; to participate and encourage others to participate in the proper observance of all days honoring veterans; to preserve the memories of our service in the armed forces of our country; to actively participate within our membership in projects related to (a) the welfare of the children of America; (b) the health of our Nation by fostering a nurses training program; and (c) selected charitable endeavors.

ARTICLE IV

The manner in which the directors are elected and appointed:

Directors (Locale Officers) shall be elected annually by the members (Voyageurs Militaire) at an announced meeting (Promenade) conducted during the month of May, as set forth in the constitution of Voiture 1606, La Societe des Quarante Hommes et Huit Chevaux, Incorporated. The directors shall be installed in their positions in the voiture (Local Chapter) by a Director (or Past Director) of Grand Voiture du Florida (the State Organization) no earlier than 45 days, or later than 15 days prior to the annual Grand Voiture du Florida Promenade (State Convention)

ARTICLE V

Limitations of Corporate Powers

The corporate powers of this corporation are as provided in section 617.0302, Florida Statutes, unless limited are as following: NONE

2. **Special Provisions.** No provisions exist which is inconsistent with state law concerning the internal affairs of this corporation, or with respect to the relative rights or interests of the members (among themselves or in the property of the corporation).
3. **Termination of membership and rights of terminated members.** Termination of membership and appeals shall be set forth in the Constitution and By-Laws of Voiture 1606
4. **Membership is non-transferrable and only one class of membership (active) is permitted.** Regulations concerning initiation, renewal and reinstatement of membership shall be as set forth in the Constitution and By-Laws of Voiture 1606 or as directed by higher authority. While membership is non-transferrable. Voyageurs Militaire (members) may transfer from one Voiture Locale to another Voiture Locale, provided the Voyageur is in good standing with his existing voiture, and with the mutual (written) consent of both voitures to transfer.
5. **Disposition of assets in the event Voiture 1606 become inactive or is dissolved.** Assets may not be disbursed to members, and all property shall be transferred to Voiture Grand du Florida if Voiture 1606 becomes inactive, or its charter is revoked. Specific instructions are as set forth in the Constitution and By-Laws of Grand du Florida, La Societe des Quarante Hommes et Huit Chevaux.
6. **Conflict with Grand and Nationale Constitution and By-Laws.** The Constitution and By-Laws of Voiture 1606 shall remain subservient to, and shall not be in conflict with the Constitution and By-Laws of the Grand du Florida, La Societe des Quarante Hommes et Huit Chevaux (both not for profit corporations).
