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Attachment to
Articles of Incorporation of
The Walter J. Turnbull Music Foundation Inc.

Said organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under the section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. The business activity for said organization is as follows: To receive and maintain personal and real property or both, subject to whatever restrictions and limitations, to use and apply the whole or any part of the income therefrom, and the principal thereof exclusively for artistic, educational, youth development and other charitable purposes. The charitable foundation will also serve to cultivate, promote, foster, sponsor and develop among its participants, and the community at large, as a public charitable foundation and program operating entity, an appreciation, understanding, taste and love of the musical arts; promote interest and participation in choral group singing through class instruction and otherwise; to increase membership in choral societies; to stimulate public interest in choral singing; to create a musical center for the advancement of such purposes; to secure the interest and support of patrons of the arts; to provide entertainment and amusement through the voluntary exploitation of its participants' talents; all for no pecuniary gain; and to conduct such as activities as from time to time found appropriate in connection with its mission.

No part of the net earnings of this organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof. No substantial part of the activities of this organization shall be the carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and this organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(e) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Upon the dissolution of this corporation, assets remaining shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

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
