The name of the corporation is Henry Development Foundation, Inc.

Article 2.

The initial registered office of the Corporation shall be at 21020 NW 38th Ct, Miami Gardens, FL 33055. The initial registered agent of the Corporation at such address shall be: Kiou Henry.

The Corporation shall not have Members.

Article 5.

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be carrying on of propaganda, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
