Said organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under the section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. The business activity for said organization is as follows: to create a more perfect union of college trained men of similar high ideals of scholarship and manhood in order to:

- (a) Stimulate the attainment of ideals and ambitions of its members.
- (b) Disseminate and inculcate those ideals among those with whom its members come in contact.
