ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

TALLARAURE, FLORID

OF

CHENOWETH FAMILY ASSOCIATION, INC. A NONPROFIT FLORIDA CORPORATION

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of this corporation is CHENOWETH FAMILY ASSOCIATION, INC., a not-for-profit Florida corporation.

ARTICLE II TERM OF EXISTENCE

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE III INCORPORATORS

The rights and interests of the incorporators shall automatically terminate when these Articles are filed with the Secretary of State.

ARTICLE IV PURPOSE

This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational and scientific purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, including the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. More particularly, this Corporation is organized to conduct programs and activities; sponsor research, sponsor promotions, raise funds, request and receive grants, gifts, contributions, dues, and bequests of money, real and personal property; or to acquire, receive, hold, invest and administer, in its own name, securities, funds, objects of value, or other property, real or personal, and make expenditures and distributions for the benefit of better understanding of and knowledge about the history and genealogy of the Chenoweth Family.

ARTICLE V PUBLICLY SUPPORTED TAX-EXEMPT NONPROFIT CORPORATION

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article IV hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE VI DISSOLUTION

- 1. Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, assets shall be distributed to another charitable non-profit corporation dedicated to genealogy, to be used exclusively for the purposes hereinabove set forth, provided that such does not impair or destroy the tax exempt status to donations, contributions, legacies or dues received by this Corporation to the extent that such tax exempt status shall be allowed under any applicable law or regulation.
- 2. Notwithstanding anything herein to the contrary, the assets of the Corporation are hereby irrevocably dedicated to charitable use; accordingly, upon dissolution, the residual assets of the Corporation shall be turned over to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in Section 501(c)(3) and Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding sections of any prior or future law, or to a federal, state or local government for exclusive public purposes.

ARTICLE VII BOARD OF DIRECTORS

- 1. The affairs of the Corporation are to be managed initially by a Board of Directors of at least three (3) Directors. Additional Directors to have an odd number of directors may be added to the Board as set forth in the duly adopted By-laws. New Directors shall be elected by the members according to the By-laws that may be in existence from time to time.
- 2. The names and addresses of the individuals, each of whom are 18 years of age or older, to serve on the initial Board of Directors are as follows:

The initial officers of the Corporation shall be the Chairman, the Vice-Chairman, the Secretary and the Treasurer and such other officers and assistant officers as may be created from time to time by the Board of Directors. The officers shall be elected in the manner provided in the By-laws that may be in existence from time to time.

ARTICLE VIII INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE, MAILING ADDRESS, AND REGISTERED AGENT

ARTICLE IX ADMINISTRATION

This Corporation is organized and shall be operated on a non-stock basis under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE X MEMBERSHIP

- 1. The qualifications for members and the manner of their admission shall be stipulated by the By-laws of the Corporation.
- 2. The Corporation shall provide for equal membership and employment opportunities to all persons regardless of race, color, religion, sex, age, disability, or national origin.

ARTICLE XI BY-LAWS

The Directors, by majority vote, are authorized to establish By-laws for the Corporation not inconsistent with these Articles of Incorporation, and to amend same from time to time. Amendments to the By-laws that are approved by directors between member meetings shall be subject to ratification or revocation by a vote of the members at the next meeting of the general membership.

ARTICLE XII AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

This Corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any provision contained in these Articles of Incorporation. Amendments to the Articles of Incorporation shall be proposed by the members in the form of a resolution, which must be done by a majority vote of all members present and those represented by proxy at any meeting of the membership called for that purpose. Notwithstanding anything herein to the contrary, amendments which are required or advisable to maintain the Corporation's tax exempt status may nevertheless be adopted at a meeting of the Board of Directors by a unanimous vote of the directors then in office.


