ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In Compliance with Chapter 617.0202, F.S., (Not for Profit)

I, the undersigned natural person of the age of eighteen (18) years or more, acting as incorporator of a corporation under the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the Corporation is X'HARI'S PALACE, INC. (the "Corporation")

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal street address and mailing address is:

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

- NAME OF STREET Said organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501©3 of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof. No substantial part of the activities of organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501©3 of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE IV MANNER OF ELECTION

The number of directors and the method of their election shall be determined by the Bylaws of the Corporation and shall be subject to change from time to time as the Bylaws may be amended. The Corporation will have no members and the management to the Corporation is vested in the Board of Directors. The number of directors constituting the initial Board of Directors of the Corporation is four (4).
