JUPITER HEALTH OUTPATIENT SERVICES, INC.**

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
These Articles of Amendment of Jupiter Health Outpatient Services, Inc., a Florida not for profit corporation (the "Corporation"), are made as of this 12<sup>th</sup> day of May 2015. The original Articles of Incorporation were filed with the Department of State of the State of Florida on May 14, 2012. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, this Florida not for profit corporation adopts the following amendments to its Articles of Incorporation:

1. Article IX is amended to read as follows:

**ARTICLE IX  
DISSOLUTION**

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, the assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction in the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

2. The amendment was approved by the member and the number of votes cast for the amendment was sufficient for approval.
