ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation shall be:

Healing Hands Outreach, Inc.

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

Healing Hands Outreach, Inc. is organized pursuant with Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, Corporation not for profit.

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is:

- 1. The Corporation is a nonprofit corporation organized exclusively for charitable, scientific, religious, educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law).
- 2. To operate a safe and enriching community outreach and recovery center in Florida. The specific purposes for which this corporation is organized include, but are not limited to: developing and building outreach activities into programs by organizing volunteers, professional and community resources into accessible counseling, intervention, education and shelter programs that provide community education, outreach and engagement, food, shelter, transitional residential housing, group home and supportive services to families and individuals that are homeless, potentially homeless, persons or individuals who have been diagnosed with substance abuse, mental illness or a combination of the two, adults with disabilities, low income families, low income refugees, and other special needs persons/groups within the community.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit)

- 3. In order to help lessen the burden of government facilities, our center will be a catalyst in developing ways to connect with people, recognize their needs, and lay the foundation to successfully phase or integrate persons into the community and/ or social service agency needed. Healing Hands Outreach inc. would assume the task of promoting acceptable community integration. We seek to establish a personal connection that provides the spark for the journey back to a vital and dignified life.
- 4. In addition to utilizing community and local government resources to help implement and meet the needs of our outlined programs. Healing Hands Outreach Inc. will also operate local group home and transitional housing facilities. Thus being able to offer immediate access to housing or shelter, for some this accessibility can be a transforming step in the individual's search for a better way to live and eventually reduce their dependence on public assistance.
- 5. No part of the assets or net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its directors, members, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the tax exempt purposes set forth in these Articles.
- 6. This Corporation shall have all of the powers of a natural person, subject only to limitations imposed by these articles, the bylaws of this Corporation and applicable laws. Notwithstanding any such powers, or any other provision of these Articles, this Corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on (i) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the code, or (ii) by corporation organized under section 170(c)(2) of the code, or (iii) by a corporation as defined in Section 617.0835 of Florida Statutes. Notwithstanding any of the above statement of purpose and powers, this Corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise of any powers that are not in furtherance of primary purpose of this Corporation.
- 7. This Corporation shall not participate in or intervene in political activities.
- 8. Upon Dissolution of the Corporation, the board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all liabilities of the Corporation if such assets exist, transfer or convey all of the remaining assets of the corporation to one or more non-profit domestic or foreign corporations, or non-profit organizations, as shall then be exempt organizations within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the code.
