

## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF CENTER OF REVIVAL, INC.

The undersigned incorporator, for the purposes of forming a corporation under the Florida Nor-for-Profit Corporation Act, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be: CENTER OF REVIVAL, INC.

#### ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business shall be 15400 Gulf Blvd., Madeira Beach, Florida 33708 and the mailing address of this corporation shall be: P. O. Box 48349, Tampa, Florida 33646.

## ARTICLE III CORPORATE PURPOSE

- A. This corporation is a religious corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Florida Not-For-Profit Corporation Code exclusively for religious purposes.
- B. Said corporation is organized exclusively for religious purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

The specific purposes of this corporation are as follows:

- (1) To disseminate the Gospel of Jesus Christ and the Word of God, to the end that people may be evangelized and believers may be conformed to the image of Jesus Christ (Mark 16:15-16; Isaiah 6:8; Acts 13:47; II Corinthians 5:20); to regularly assemble for fellowship to worship God in Spirit and in truth (Hebrews 10:25) and to cooperate in the building up of the whole body of Christ (Ephesians 2:19-22).
- (2) To provide basic New Testament discipleship to all who are approved for this purpose by the Elders. (Acts 6:7, 11:26, 14:20-23)
- (3) To establish and maintain a church and to provide a place of public worship and prayer in accordance with the directions of the Holy Spirit (I Kings 8:12-21; Psalm 96:9, 122:1; I Corinthians 5:40); to spread the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ through the preaching and teaching of the Bible to bring the unsaved to Christ (Mark 6:15; Romans 1:15-16; I Thessalonians 5:9; II Thessalonians 2:13; II Timothy 3:15), and to build up the saved in Christian grace and living. (Ephesians 4:11-16; Hebrews 3:1-4; I Corinthians 3:9-15) Pursuant thereto, the following activities and guidelines shall be established:
- 1. A recognized Statement of Faith, Code of Doctrine, discipline and form of worship shall be established. (Acts 8:37, 15:11, 16:31; Romans 4:20-25, 10:9-11; I Thessalonians 4:14-17; I Peter 1:21)
- 2. A biblical form of government shall be established (Exodus 18; Ephesians 4:8-11; I Corinthians 12:27-31)

- 3. Ordination of ministers upon completion of the prescribed course of Study, designated by this church. (I Chronicles 9:22-23; Titus 1:5; I Corinthians 7:17; Acts 14:23)
- 4. An organization of ministers shall be established to minister to the congregation of CENTER OF REVIVAL, INC. (Colossians 4:17; Il Timothy 1:16-18; I Corinthians 16:15; Romans 16:1)
- 5. Establishment of a covenant fellowship based upon acceptance of and conformity to the belief of the church. (Acts 15:41, 16:5)
- 6. Propagate the Word of the Gospel through seminars, the establishment of Church literature and other forms of mass media for the purpose of educating the individual in the Word of God. (Psalm 96:10; Proverbs 13:17; Mark 13:10; Acts 13:47)
- 7. Establishment of various religious services pursuant to the recognized Statement of Faith, form of worship, discipline of the church and the establishment of Sunday school and religious schools for Christians and educational instruction of children and adults to exalt the standard of Christian living and the divine leadership of our divine Lord and Master. (Proverbs 8:10, 13:1; Zephaniah 3:7; II Timothy 3:16)
- 8. Establishment of a Bible Training School or School of Theology for the preparation of ministers who minister to CENTER OF REVIVAL, INC. and to ordain ministers and Christian workers to the edification and the unity of the body of Christ. (Psalm 40:9-10; John 14:26; I Peter 4:6)
- (4) To send forth home and foreign missionaries to the spreading of the Gospel and in extending the Gospel of God throughout the world (Mark 16:15-16; Acts 13:47, 4:29-30).
- (5) To support the religious activities of nonprofit religious organizations whose primary objective is to engage in the conduct of religious worship. (I Corinthians 9:9-10, 16:1-4; II Corinthians 9:6-7, 11-13)
- (6) To print, publish, and distribute and sell books, magazines and other literature in connection with the purposes of this corporation; to sell, record and reproduce tapes, radio, and television programs in connection with the purposes of this corporation to produce and distribute radio and television programs (Deuteronomy 31:19; I Chronicles 16:23-24; Psalm 68:4; Revelation 14:2).
- (7) To establish, maintain and conduct seminars for the instruction of children and adults for religious instruction. (Psalms 40:9-10; I Peter 4:6; John 14:26)
- (8) To establish and maintain a counseling service for the use of the Church and public and to provide access to such counseling service by virtue of telephonic communication (Proverbs 12:15,25, 15:22; Jeremiah 49:20; I Thessalonians 5:14); to assist the body of Christ with employment and financial counseling including off-site Institute of Vocation (Job Training) (I Corinthians 3:8; Colossians 4:1; Ecclesiastes 9:10; I Timothy 6:9-10; John 6:27); A Christians in Human Services Group (I Corinthians 10:24, 12:5; Job 29:16; Luke 6:34; Galatians 5:13, 6:10) and to provide for ministry through Family Services (Deuteronomy 15:7; Nehemiah 8:10; Matthew 5:42; Galatians 6:2; Hebrews 13:16).
- (9) To establish and maintain an evangelistic association to spread the gospel of Jesus Christ both in the United States and abroad throughout the world as the Lord leads. (Jeremiah 50:2; Matthew 24:14; Romans 1:16; I Peter 1:24-25; Psalms 51:13; I Corinthians 9:16)
- (10) To propagate the Word of the Gospel through seminars, radio, television, establishment of Church literature, and other forms of mass media for the purpose of educating the individual in the Word of God. (Psalms 96:10; Proverbs 13:17; Mark 13:10; Acts 13:47)
- (11) To provide home care programs for the members of the church, their families and friends as a way to network the church and its associate ministries. (I Timothy 5:4; Acts 2:46, 5:42, 18:7-11, 20:20; I Corinthians 16:19; Colossians 4:15)
- (12) To provide a prayer ministry to assist those in the church and those in need who need agreement

in receiving a touch from the Lord. (Acts 12:5, 14:23, 16:9, 8:22; Isaiah 53:12; Romans 8:27,34; I Timothy 2:1-4)

(13) To carry on charitable work for the poor and lost: (Leviticus 25:35; Matthew 25:34-40; Galatians 6:10; Mark 14:7)

Feed the Hungry Soup Kitchen, Food Pantry, Clothes Closet (Matthew 25:35; Psalm 146:7; Luke 3:11, 4:18)

Prison Ministry (Psalm 142:7; I Peter 3:19)

After-care Center for Released Prisoners (Job 3:18; Psalm 69:33; Isaiah 49:9-10)

Sick and Shut-in Ministry (James 5:14-15; Mark 16:18)

Unwed Mother's Home (Luke 1:39-40,56)

Abused Wives and Children's Home (Exodus 22:22-24; Deuteronomy 10:18; Acts 6:1; I Timothy 5:3-12,16)

Housing for the Homeless and Runaways (Leviticus 25:35; Proverbs 19:17; Luke 3:11; II Corinthians 8:14-15)

Care for and assist handicapped individuals (Leviticus 19:32; Isaiah 35:5; Mark 7:37; Luke 7:32,14:13-14)

To provide ministry to homosexuals and prostitutes, so they may be taught the Gospel of Jesus Christ (I Corinthians 1:27-31, 6:9-11; Hebrews 10:22; Luke 14:12-24; Matthew 22:2-10, John 8:1-11).

Housing for those with addictive behavior (Luke 4:18).

Drug and Alcohol Program (Isaiah 5:11, 19:14,20; Habakkuk 2:15; Joel 2:32; Matthew 9:12; Psalm 121:2).

The mentally disturbed (Matthew 4:24, 17:15).

- (14) To establish and maintain a Christian bookstore for the benefit of the students and members of the Church and their guests (Psalm 68:11; Acts 13:39).
- (15) To provide tripartite therapeutic counseling for the spirit, mind and body. (I Thessalonians 5:23; I Corinthians 6:20; Jeremiah 42:4; Psalms 25:9); to cooperate with the church in the building up of the whole body of Christ. (Ephesians 2:19-22)
- (16) To own and operate Radio and Television Stations for the purpose of the dissemination of the Gospel of Jesus Christ through word and music (Psalms 96:10; Proverbs 13:17; Mark 13:10; Acts 13;47; Deuteronomy 31:19; I Chronicles 16:23-24; Psalms 68:4; Revelation 14:2)
- (17) To establish and raise up churches and pastors to lead them; to provide spiritual oversight to those churches and pastors who desire the oversight and to provide spiritual accountability for the conduct of independent churches and ministers. (Acts 15:6, 15:22-29, 15:41, 16:5)
- (18) To support the religious activities of nonprofit religious organizations whose primary objective is to engage in the conduct of religious worship. (I Corinthians 9:9-10, 16:1-4; II Corinthians 9:6-7, 11-13)
- (19) To provide for the instruction and dissemination of information about and furtherance of the teachings of the Christian faith and tenets and to provide a forum for exchange of information concerning the Word. (I Corinthians 2:2, 3:9-10, 11:23-34; Hebrews 6:1-3)
- (20) To conduct pastor training seminars for national pastors; and to conduct all missionary outreach programs necessary to the dissemination of the Word of God throughout the world. (Luke 6:40; Psalms 32:8; Proverbs 1:5)
- (21) To coordinate and transact prison ministries. (Psalm 142:7; I Peter 3:19; Acts 16:25-34; Luke

4:18)

- (22) To perpetuate and stimulate the physical and spiritual growth of the local church and to train and assist those within the local church who are called of God into positions of workers, ministries of helps, and into the five-fold ministry. (I Peter 4:6; John 14:26)
- (23) To establish auxiliaries, clubs, and societies of a religious nature and to promote and encourage Christian fellowship between its members (Acts 15:41, 16:5)
- (24) To further all religious and charitable work and for such purposes to adopt and establish Bylaws, rules, regulations in accordance with the law and not inconsistent with this Articles of Incorporation. (Joshua 1:7-8; Habakkuk 2:2-3; Romans 7:12, 10:4)
- (25) To do all those things allowed and permitted to be done under law and specifically those set forth in the Florida Not-for-Profit Corporation Code so long as the same may be done by a corporation approved as a 501(c)(3) organization under the Internal Revenue Code.

## ARTICLE IV MANNER OF ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

The manner in which the directors are elected are set forth in the Bylaws.

## ARTICLE V INITIAL REGISTERED AGENT AND STREET ADDRESS

## ARTICLE VII

The period of the duration of this corporation is perpetual, unless dissolved according to the law.

## ARTICLE VIII BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The ministry shall have a Board of Directors of three (3) initially. The names and addresses of the initial Board of Directors who shall serve until the first election are:

- 1. Dayna Muldoon, 15400 Gulf Blvd., Madeira Beach, Florida 33708.
- 2. Dennis Jenkins, 25903 Goldtree Court, Wesley Chapel, Florida 33544.
- 3. Randy White, 4301 Bayshore Blvd., Tampa, Florida 33611

There shall be a Board of Directors for this corporation which shall consist of not less than three (3) and no more than seven (7) members.

Vacancies in the Board of Directors shall be filled by the appointment of a Director by the President until the next election of the Directors. The Directors shall have all the power as set forth in the Bylaws.

## ARTICLE IX LIABILITY

No member of CENTER OF REVIVAL, INC. shall be liable for its debts nor shall any members' property be so liable.

#### ARTICLE X EXEMPT STATUS AND DISSOLUTION

Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Articles hereof.

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation.

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

#### ARTICLE XI BYLAWS

The Bylaws of CENTER OF REVIVAL, INC. shall be adopted and amended by the Board of Directors.

#### **ARTICLE XII**

#### **DECLARATION OF ASSETS**

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to religious and charitable purposes, and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer, or member thereof, or to the benefit of any private individual.

## ARTICLE XIII GENDER

In referring to directors, officers, chairman, members, deacons, incorporators or assistants within these Bylaws, words of any gender shall be deemed to include any other gender and a reference to the singular shall include the plural, and vice versa, unless the context indicate that such reading would be inappropriate.

#### ARTICLE XIV AMENDMENTS

Amendments to this Articles of Incorporation may be proposed by a resolution adopted by the Board of Directors. After notification to the members of the proposed amendment, such amendment shall be adopted by the Board of Directors by an affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of the Directors present and voting at a meeting at which a quorum is present.
