



# ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION ARTICLE I NAME

#### 1.01 Name

The name of this corporation shall be Homes for the less Fortunate of Haiti Inc. The business of the corporation may be conducted as Homes for the Less Fortunate of Haiti Inc. or HLFH Inc.

#### 1.02 Location

The place where the principal office of the Corporation is to be located is in the State of Florida in the City of Miami Dade County.

# ARTICLE II DURATION

# 2.01 Duration

The period of duration of the corporation is perpetual.

# ARTICLE III PURPOSE

# 3.01 Purpose

Homes for the Less Fortunate of Haiti Inc. is a non-profit corporation and shall operate exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future Federal tax code. Homes for the Less Fortunate of Haiti Inc.'s purpose is to eliminate poor housing quality in Haiti by helping to build or rebuild homes for families in Haiti whose homes are in less than acceptable living conditions. We also aim to increase educational opportunities for school age children. We will accomplish this through fundraising and working with families who needs assistance.

# 3.02 Public Benefit

Homes for the Less Fortunate of Haiti Inc. is designated as a public benefit corporation.

# ARTICLE IV NON-PROFIT NATURE

# 4.01 Non-profit Nature

Homes for the Less Fortunate of Haiti Inc. is organized exclusively for charitable purposes including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. No part of the net earnings of Homes for the Less Fortunate of Haiti Inc. shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof.

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on

behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by any organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Homes for the Less Fortunate of Haiti Inc. is not organized and shall not be operated for the private gain of any person. The property of the corporation is irrevocably dedicated to its charitable purposes. No part of the directors, receipts, or net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to any individual. The corporation may, however, pay reasonable compensation for services rendered, and make other payments and distributions consistent with these Articles.

# 4.02 Personal Liability

No officer of director of this corporation shall be personally liable for the debts or obligations of Homes for the Less Fortunate of Haiti Inc. of any nature whatsoever, nor shall any of the property or assets of the officers or directors be subject to the payment of the debts or obligations of this corporation.

# 4.03 Dissolution

Upon termination or dissolution of the Homes for the Less Fortunate of Haiti Inc. any assets lawfully available for distribution shall be distributed to one (1) or more qualifying organizations described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or described in any corresponding provision of any successor statute) which organization or organizations have a charitable purpose which, at least generally, includes a purpose similar to the terminating or dissolving corporation.

The organization to receive the assets of the Homes for the Less Fortunate of Haiti Inc. hereunder shall be selected by the discretion of a majority of the managing body of the Homes for the Less fortunate of Haiti Inc. and if its members cannot so agree, then the recipient organization shall be selected pursuant to a verified petition in equity filed in a court of proper jurisdiction against the Homes for the Less Fortunate of Haiti Inc. by one (1) or more of its managing body which verified petition shall contain such statements as reasonably indicate the applicability of this section. The court upon a finding that this section is applicable shall select the qualifying organization or organizations to receive the assets to be distributed, giving preference if practicable to organizations located within the State of Montana. In the event that the court shall find that this section is applicable but that there is no qualifying organization known to it which has a charitable purpose, which, at least generally, includes a purpose similar to this corporation, then the court shall direct the distribution of its assets lawfully available for distribution to the Treasurer of the State of Montana to be added to the general fund.

# 4.03 Prohibited Distributions

No part of the net earnings, properties of the directors of this corporation, on dissolution or otherwise, shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers or other private person or individual, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered

to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III, Section 3.01.

# 4.04 Restricted Activities

No substantial part of the corporation's activities shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene (including the publishing or distribution of statements) in any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

# 4.05 Prohibited Activities

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on (I) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax as an organization described by Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (II) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

# ARTICLE V BOARD OF DIRECTORS

#### 5.01 Governance

Homes for the Less Fortunate of Haiti Inc. shall be governed by its board of directors.
