## Amended Articles of Incorporation of

Women of Destiny Plus Community Development, Corp.

### Article III. Purposes and Powers

Said organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distribution to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal code. To present a set of programs, projects, services, seminars, and lectures for the socioeconomic development of the Intergenerational sector of Seniors, Infants, Children and High Risk Youth. The programs will include but not be limited to helping seniors locate proper Assisted Living facilitation, to care and assist persons who are ill with chores and more, to provide gift baskets during holidays and at other times when available, to assist in child care and children programs at local facilities. Christmas toy drives, Thanksgiving Food Drives, Back to school supply Drives, to assist persons with locating transitional housing facilitation, for people with with HIV/Aids,, feeding and clothing programs, To assist with helping persons to locate proper affordable housing for low to moderate income persons, to assist with locating transitional housing for battered and abused women, temporary and permanent housing for Veterans. To assist those in need with social benefits including food stamps and more. To promote and to provide education and information to raise the socioeconomic development of the Veterans and other low income persons. To interact with governmental, faith and other community based organizations to enhance programs, projects and serves to those in need.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall insure to the benefit of, or be distributed to its members, trustees, directors, officers and other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distribution in furtherance of Section 501(c)(3) purposes. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of the Articles, the corporation, shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code.)

Upon dissolution of this corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes with the meaning of Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.
