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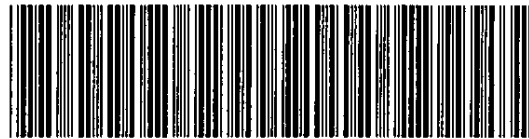

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**

The undersigned incorporator(s), a natural person 18 years of age or older, in order to form a corporate entity pursuant to Chapter 617.0202, F.S. under the State of Florida Statutes, adopts the following articles of incorporation.

**ARTICLE I      NAME**

The name of this corporation (which is hereafter called the "Corporation") shall be known as: ENSLEY YOUTH SPORTS ASSOCIATION INC.

**ARTICLE II      OFFICE**

The principal place of business address shall be 551 E. Nine Mile Road, Pensacola, Florida 32514 and the mailing address will be Post Office Box 1148, Gonzalez, Florida 32560.

**ARTICLE III      PURPOSES**

This Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, scientific and educational purposes, more specifically to youth sports including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. Without limiting the foregoing, the Corporation is dedicated to the promotion and sponsorship of youth sports, and its principal purposes are to (a) provide opportunities for youth to participate in football and cheer activities; (b) teach and train youth in football and cheer skills; (c) promote sportsmanship and develop leadership; (d) develop physical fitness and mental alertness; and (e) provide an enjoyable recreational activity.

**ARTICLE IV      LIMITATIONS**

At all times shall the following operate as conditions restricting the operations and activities of the Corporation:

No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or others private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purpose set forth in the purpose clause hereof.

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall constitute the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, or any initiative or referendum before the public, and the Corporation shall not



participate in, or intervene in (including by publication or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provisions of this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Notwithstanding the designated purposes of the Corporation, all services shall be provided and all activities of the Corporation shall be conducted in a manner which is free from discrimination on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, sexual preference, national origin, age, handicap and familial status.

#### **ARTICLE V                      MEMBERSHIP/BOARD OF DIRECTORS**

The corporation shall have no members. The management of the affairs of the corporation shall be vested in a Board of Directors, as defined in the corporation's bylaws. No Director shall have any right, title, or interest in or to any property of the corporation.

The number of Directors constituting the first Board of Directors is three (3), their names and addresses being as follows:

**ARTICLE IX      DISSOLUTION**

Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of by the District Court of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
