Purpose:

- SECRETARY OF STATE TALL AHASSEE. FLORIBA religious, and educational purposes within the meaning of Social Control Research Co Internal Revenue Code of 1986, including, but not limited to, for such purpose as the establishing and maintaining of religious places of worship; the building, maintaining, and operating of churches, parsonages, schools, chapels, radio stations, television stations, rescue missions, print shops, day-care centers (nurseries), camps, assisted living centers, cemeteries, and any other ministry that the Church may be led of God to establish, and to exercise all other powers conferred upon it by its charter or by the applicable nonprofit Bylaws as the same may be hereinafter amended.
- (B) Specific. Landmark Baptist Church exists to glorify God by carrying out two primary functions:
  - 1. Evangelism: To fulfill part one of our Savior's Great Commission to the Church to make disciples (Christ-followers) in our community, country, and in the nations abroad (Matthew 28:19-20; Mark 16:15; Acts 1:8). This is why our Church exists in the world. This involves reaching unsaved people for Christ through weekly loving outreach visitation and by building relationships with them at home, work, and at play.
  - 2. Edification: To fulfill part two of our Savior's Great Commission to the Church to teach Christ-followers so they as individuals, and the Church as a whole, will grow to full maturity in Christ, will honor and glorify God, will become a community of believers, and will become a dynamic witness in the world. This involves baptizing people after they have trusted Christ and adding them to the Church membership, teaching people how to become functioning followers of Christ through practical teaching and preaching of the Word of God, and connecting or assimilating members of the Church in a meaningful way to a small group (such as a Sunday school class) which will provide fellowship and build Biblical community in our Church.
