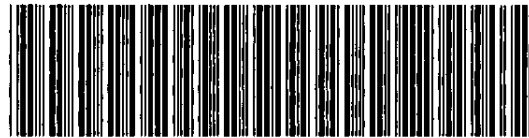

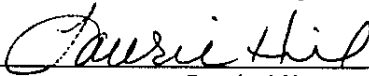

ARTICLE III – PURPOSE

Christian Chamber of Commerce-Tampa Bay, Inc. is organized to unite and equip business people who desire to follow Jesus Christ in the workplace. We will attract Christian business people by meeting regularly to encourage, equip, and educate Christ followers to make an impact in their own lives, their families, and to effect change in their workplaces.

The Corporation is organized exclusively for such purposes that qualify as exempt under section 501(c)(6) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE VIII- DISSOLUTION

Upon dissolution of the Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(6) or 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or state or local government for public purpose.

Any such asset not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purpose or to such organization or organizations as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
