Article III

The specific purpose for which this corporation is organized is:

14 MAR | 4 AM | |: 33 Said organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt -i = i = iorganizations under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any, FLORIDA

- (a) Raise funds from the public and from all other sources available; receive and maintain such funds and expend principal and income there from.
- (b) Establish, operate, promote, or make grants for various programs designed to fulfill the charitable, educational, scientific, religious, and cultural needs of the Vedic Community within the US and charitable works worldwide.
- (c) Acquire, own, use, leases as lessor or lessee, convey and otherwise deal in and with real and personal property and any interest therein.
- (d) Contract with other organizations for-profit and not-for-profit, with individuals, and with governmental agencies.
- (e) Otherwise operate exclusively for charitable, scientific, or educational purposes, within the meaning of \$50(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, in the course of which operation:
  - No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof.
  - No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be the 2. carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
  - Notwithstanding any other provisions of this document, the organization 3. shall not operate for any purposes not permitted by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

## **Article IX Dissolution**

Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
